HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 22

1 A Resolution recognizing and congratulating the
2 Kirkwood Community College women's basketball team
3 on its historic performance in the 2025 basketball
4 season.

5 WHEREAS, the Kirkwood Community College Eagles
6 entered the National Junior College Athletic
7 Association (NJCAA) Division II national basketball
8 tournament as the number one seed, which it held
9 throughout the season; and

10 WHEREAS, Kirkwood this season won their fifth
11 consecutive Region 11 tournament title, regular season
12 championship, and district title; and

13 WHEREAS, Kirkwood set an NJCAA Division II record
14 with an incredible 54-game win streak over the past two
15 seasons while extending their home winning streak to 74
16 games; and

17 WHEREAS, Kirkwood, after winning the national
18 championship in 2024, finished the 2025 season with a
19 remarkable 33-2 record for a fourth place finish; and

20 WHEREAS, sophomore Jenna Twedt was named to the 2025
21 NJCAA Division II National Tournament All-Tournament
22 Team for her stellar performance throughout the
23 tournament, and for a second consecutive season; and

24 WHEREAS, Kim Muhl continued his remarkable 35-season
25 run as head coach of the Eagles, leading all NJCAA
26 women's basketball coaches in career victories; NOW
27 THEREFORE,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,
2 That the House of Representatives recognizes and
3 congratulates the Kirkwood Community College women's
4 basketball team for its outstanding basketball season
5 this year; and
