

House Study Bill 531 - Introduced

A BILL FOR

1 An Act prohibiting an increase in the amount of tuition and
2 mandatory fees charged to resident undergraduate students
3 at regents institutions for a period of time and including
4 effective date provisions.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 262.9, subsection 19, Code 2026, is
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. d. Prohibit any increase in the amount of
4 tuition or mandatory fees charged by an institution of higher
5 education under the board's control to resident undergraduate
6 students on or after the effective date of this Act. This
7 paragraph is repealed July 1, 2031.

8 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
9 importance, takes effect upon enactment.

10 EXPLANATION

11 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
12 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

13 This bill requires the state board of regents to prohibit any
14 increase in the amount of tuition or mandatory fees charged by
15 an institution of higher education under the board's control to
16 resident undergraduate students on or after the effective date of
17 the bill until July 1, 2031.

18 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
