**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act modifying provisions related to school concussion and  
2 brain injury policies.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 280.13C, subsection 2, paragraph e, Code  
2 2025, is amended to read as follows:

3 e. "Licensed health care provider" means a physician,  
4 physician assistant, chiropractor, advanced registered nurse  
5 practitioner, nurse, person who holds a doctorate in psychology  
6 with specialty training in neuropsychology or concussion  
7 management, physical therapist, occupational therapist, or  
8 athletic trainer licensed by a board designated under section  
9 147.13.

#### EXPLANATION

13 This bill modifies provisions related to school concussion and  
14 brain injury policies.

15 Current Code section 280.13C requires the department of  
16 health and human services, the Iowa high school athletic  
17 association, and the Iowa girls high school athletic union to  
18 work together to develop training materials and courses regarding  
19 concussions and brain injuries, to distribute information related  
20 to concussions and brain injuries, and to develop protocols  
21 related to when a student may return to participation in an  
22 extracurricular interscholastic activity after showing signs,  
23 symptoms, or behaviors consistent with a concussion or brain  
24 injury. Current Code section 280.13C also establishes standards  
25 related to when a student, at the direction of a licensed  
26 health care provider, among others, should be removed from  
27 participation in an extracurricular interscholastic activity due  
28 to signs, symptoms, or behaviors consistent with a concussion or  
29 brain injury, as well as when the student may return following  
30 removal. The bill modifies the definition of "licensed health  
31 care provider" for purposes of Code section 280.13C to include  
32 a person who holds a doctorate in psychology with specialty  
33 training in neuropsychology or concussion management.
