**A BILL FOR**

- 1 An Act relating to the sale or offer for sale of certain firearm
- 2 devices, and making penalties applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 724.29, Code 2026, is amended to read as  
2 follows:

3 **724.29 Firearm devices.**

4 1. For purposes of this section, "trigger crank" means any  
5 device or instrument to be attached to a firearm that repeatedly  
6 activates the trigger of the firearm through the use of a  
7 lever or other part that is turned in a circular motion.

8 "Trigger crank" does not include any weapon initially designed  
9 and manufactured to fire through the use of a crank or lever.

10 2. A person who sells or offers for sale a ~~manual or~~  
11 ~~power-driven trigger activating device constructed and designed~~  
12 ~~so that when attached to a firearm increases the rate of fire of~~  
13 ~~the firearm~~ trigger crank is guilty of an aggravated misdemeanor.

14 EXPLANATION

15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
16 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

17 This bill relates to the sale or offer for sale of certain  
18 firearm devices.

19 Under current law, a person who sells or offers for sale a  
20 manual or power-driven trigger activating device constructed and  
21 designed so that when attached to a firearm increases the rate of  
22 fire of the firearm is guilty of an aggravated misdemeanor. An  
23 aggravated misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more  
24 than two years and a fine of at least \$855 but not more than  
25 \$8,540.

26 The bill changes the restricted devices to only include  
27 trigger cranks. The bill defines "trigger crank" as any device  
28 or instrument to be attached to a firearm that repeatedly  
29 activates the trigger of the firearm through the use of a lever  
30 or other part that is turned in a circular motion. A weapon  
31 initially designed and manufactured to fire through the use of a  
32 crank or lever is not included in this definition.
