A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to invasion of privacy, including attempts to
2 invade privacy, and making penalties applicable.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 709.21, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph
2 1, Code 2026, is amended to read as follows:

3 A person who knowingly views, photographs, or films another
4 person, or attempts to view, photograph, or film another person,
5 for the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual desire of
6 any person, commits invasion of privacy if all of the following
7 apply:

8 EXPLANATION

9 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
10 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

11 This bill relates to invasion of privacy, including attempts
12 to invade privacy.

13 The bill provides that a person who knowingly views,
14 photographs, or films another person, or attempts to view,
15 photograph, or film another person, for the purpose of arousing
16 or gratifying the sexual desire of any person, commits invasion
17 of privacy if certain requirements are met.

18 A person convicted of invasion of privacy or an attempt to
19 invade privacy is guilty of an aggravated misdemeanor. An
20 aggravated misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more
21 than two years and a fine of at least \$855 but not more than
22 \$8,540.

23 A person convicted of a violation of Code section 709.21 is
24 required to register as a tier II sex offender unless the offense
25 is committed against a person under 13 years of age, in which
26 case the offense is reclassified as a tier III offense.
