**A BILL FOR**

- 1 An Act relating to the cessation of appropriations to the Iowa
- 2 resources enhancement and protection fund.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 455A.18, subsection 3, paragraph a, Code  
2 2026, is amended to read as follows:

3 a. For each fiscal year ~~of the fiscal period beginning July~~  
4 ~~1, 1997, and ending June 30, 2028,~~ there is appropriated from the  
5 general fund, to the Iowa resources enhancement and protection  
6 fund, the amount of twenty million dollars, to be used as  
7 provided in this chapter. However, in any fiscal year of the  
8 fiscal period, if moneys from the lottery are appropriated by the  
9 state to the fund, the amount appropriated under this subsection  
10 shall be reduced by the amount appropriated from the lottery.

11 EXPLANATION

12 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
13 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

14 This bill relates to appropriations to the Iowa resources  
15 enhancement and protection (REAP) fund.

16 Under current law, each fiscal year, \$20 million is  
17 appropriated from the general fund of the state to the REAP  
18 fund. The annual appropriation is currently set to expire June  
19 30, 2028. The bill removes the expiration date of the annual  
20 appropriation to the REAP fund.
