**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to the distribution of the department of  
2 administrative services' report on state employee salaries.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 8A.341, subsection 2, Code 2026, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. If money is appropriated for this purpose, by November 1  
4 of each year supply a report which contains the name, gender,  
5 county, or city of residence when possible, official title,  
6 salary received during the previous fiscal year, base salary as  
7 computed on July 1 of the current fiscal year, and traveling and  
8 subsistence expense of the personnel of each of the departments,  
9 boards, and commissions of the state government except personnel  
10 who receive an annual salary of less than one thousand dollars.  
11 The number of the personnel and the total amount received by them  
12 shall be shown for each department in the report. All employees  
13 who have drawn salaries, fees, or expense allowances from more  
14 than one department or subdivision shall be listed separately  
15 under the proper departmental heading. On the request of the  
16 director, the head of each department, board, or commission shall  
17 furnish the data covering that agency. The report shall be  
18 ~~distributed upon request without charge in an electronic medium~~  
19 ~~to each caucus of the general assembly, the legislative services~~  
20 ~~agency, the chief clerk of the house of representatives, and~~  
21 ~~the secretary of the senate~~ made available on an internet site  
22 maintained by the department. Copies Upon request, copies of the  
23 report shall be made available to ~~other~~ persons in an electronic  
24 medium upon payment of a fee, which shall not exceed the cost of  
25 providing the copy of the report. Sections 22.2 through 22.5  
26 apply to the report. All funds from the sale of the report  
27 shall be deposited in the printing revolving fund established in  
28 section 8A.345.

29 EXPLANATION

30 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
31 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

32 This bill requires the department of administrative services  
33 to make the report on state employee salaries available on its  
34 internet site and to provide an electronic copy of the report  
35 to any person upon request and payment of a fee. The bill

1 also strikes the requirement that the department provide without  
2 charge an electronic copy of the report to each caucus of the  
3 general assembly, the legislative services agency, the chief  
4 clerk of the house of representatives, and the secretary of the  
5 senate.
