**A BILL FOR**

- 1 An Act relating to schedule III controlled substances, and making
- 2 penalties applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 124.208, Code 2026, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 10. *Abortifacients.* Any material, compound,  
4 mixture, or preparation that contains any quantity of the  
5 following substances:

6 a. (±)-METHYL (1R,2R,3R)-3-HYDROXY-2-((E)-(4RS)-4-HYDROXY-4-  
7 METHYL-1-OCTENYL)-5-OXOCYCLOPENTANEHEPTANOATE. Other name:  
8 Misoprostol.

9 b. (aa [beta], 17 [beta])-11-[4-(dimethylamino)-phenyl]-17-  
10 hydroxy-17-(1-propynyl)estra-4,9-dien-3-one-11 [beta]-[4-(N,N-  
11 dimethylamino)phenyl]-17[alpha]-(propyl-1-ynyl)-[delta]-4,9-  
12 estradiene-17 [beta]-ol-3-one 11-((4-dimethylamino) phenyl)-1  
13 7-hydroxy-17-(1-propynyl) estra-4,9-dien-3-one. Other name:  
14 Mifepristone.

15 c. N-[4-[[2,4-diamino-6-pteridinyl)methyl]methylamino]  
16 benzoyl]-L-glutamic acid. Other name: Methotrexate.

17 EXPLANATION

18 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
19 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

20 This bill relates to schedule III controlled substances.

21 The bill includes misoprostol, mifepristone, and methotrexate  
22 as schedule III controlled substances.

23 A person who manufactures, distributes, or dispenses a  
24 schedule III controlled substance commits a class "C" felony and,  
25 in addition to the provisions of Code section 902.9, subsection  
26 1, paragraph "d", shall be punished by a fine of not less than  
27 \$1,000 nor more than \$50,000.
