A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the district-to-community college sharing or
- 2 concurrent enrollment program.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 261E.8, Code 2026, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 10. If a student fails a community
4 college-offered class, or a class taught by a community
5 college-employed instructor, the student's parent or guardian,
6 if the student is a minor, or the student, if the student is
7 eighteen years of age or older or is an emancipated minor, shall,
8 upon the request of the school district or accredited nonpublic
9 school through which the student is accessing the program, pay
10 to the school district or accredited nonpublic school an amount
11 equal to the amount the school district or accredited nonpublic
12 school paid to the community college pursuant to the contract
13 entered into under this section that is directly associated
14 with the student's participation in the community college-offered
15 class or the class taught by a community college-employed
16 instructor.

17 EXPLANATION

18 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
19 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

20 This bill relates to the district-to-community college sharing
21 or concurrent enrollment program, which is established under Code
22 section 261E.8 and allows high school students to enroll in
23 eligible nonsectarian courses at or through community colleges
24 and earn college credits. The bill provides that if a student
25 fails a community college-offered class, or a class taught by
26 a community college-employed instructor, the student's parent or
27 guardian or the student are required, upon the request of the
28 school district or accredited nonpublic school through which the
29 student is accessing the program, to pay to the school an amount
30 equal to the amount the school paid to the community college
31 pursuant to the contract entered into under Code section 261E.8
32 that is directly associated with the student's participation in
33 the community college-offered class or the class taught by a
34 community college-employed instructor.
