**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act designating kratom as a schedule I controlled substance,  
2 and making penalties applicable.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 124.204, subsection 4, Code 2026, is  
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. *cq.* Kratom, meaning any parts of the plant  
4 *Mitragyna speciosa*, whether growing or not, as well as synthetic  
5 equivalents of the substances contained in the plant, and any  
6 compound, manufacture, salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation  
7 of that plant, including but not limited to mitragynine and  
8 7-hydroxymitragynine.

EXPLANATION

10 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
11 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

12 This bill designates kratom as a hallucinogenic schedule I  
13 controlled substance.

14 A person possessing kratom is guilty of a serious misdemeanor  
15 for a first offense. A person who commits a subsequent violation  
16 is guilty of an aggravated misdemeanor. A person who has  
17 previously been convicted two or more times is guilty of a class  
18 "D" felony. A serious misdemeanor is punishable by confinement  
19 for no more than one year and a fine of at least \$430 but not  
20 more than \$2,560. An aggravated misdemeanor is punishable by  
21 confinement for no more than two years and a fine of at least  
22 \$855 but not more than \$8,540. A class "D" felony is punishable  
23 by confinement for no more than five years and a fine of at least  
24 \$1,025 but not more than \$10,245.
