A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to licensing requirements of private
- 2 investigative agencies and security agents.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 80A.4, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code
2 2026, is amended to read as follows:

3 c. Has ~~never~~ not been convicted of a felony or aggravated
4 misdemeanor within the ten years preceding the application.

5 EXPLANATION

6 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
7 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

8 This bill relates to licensing requirements of private
9 investigative agencies and security agents.

10 The bill provides that a license or renewal will not be
11 issued unless the applicant has not been convicted of a felony
12 or aggravated misdemeanor within the ten years preceding the
13 application. Current law provides that a license or renewal
14 will not be issued if the applicant has ever been convicted of
15 a felony or an aggravated misdemeanor.
