A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the administration of gene-based vaccines, and
- 2 providing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. **727.13 Administration of gene-based**
2 **vaccines.**

3 1. A person shall not provide or administer a gene-based
4 vaccine to another person in this state.

5 2. A person who violates this section is guilty of a simple
6 misdemeanor and is subject to a fine of five hundred dollars per
7 incident.

8 3. The appropriate licensing board within the department of
9 inspections, appeals, and licensing shall review the license of a
10 person licensed under chapter 147 who violates this section.

11 4. For purposes of this section, "gene-based vaccine" means
12 a vaccine developed using messenger ribonucleic acid technology,
13 modified messenger ribonucleic acid technology, self-amplifying
14 messenger ribonucleic acid technology, or deoxyribonucleic acid
15 technology.

16 EXPLANATION

17 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
18 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

19 This bill relates to the administration of gene-based
20 vaccines.

21 The bill provides that a person shall not provide or
22 administer a gene-based vaccine to another person in this state.
23 A person who violates the bill is guilty of a simple misdemeanor
24 and is subject to a fine of \$500 per incident.

25 The bill directs the appropriate licensing board within the
26 department of inspections, appeals, and licensing to review
27 the license of a person licensed under Code chapter 147
28 (health-related professions) who violates the bill. The bill
29 defines gene-based vaccine as a vaccine developed using messenger
30 ribonucleic acid technology, modified messenger ribonucleic
31 acid technology, self-amplifying messenger ribonucleic acid
32 technology, or deoxyribonucleic acid technology.
