A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing for a monument to Martin Treptow on the capitol
- 2 complex grounds.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. MARTIN TREPTOW — CAPITOL COMPLEX MONUMENT.

2 1. The department of administrative services, in consultation
3 with the capitol planning commission, shall authorize the
4 placement of a monument to Martin Treptow on the capitol complex
5 grounds subject to the requirements of this section.

6 2. The department of administrative services shall solicit
7 and approve an application for the construction of a monument to
8 Martin Treptow as an Iowa state capitol complex site feature.
9 An application for the construction of the monument must specify
10 the design concept for the monument, provide an estimated total
11 cost for the site feature, identify planned sources of funding,
12 provide a proposed timeline for the project, and such other
13 information as the department requires. Each proposed design
14 concept must include a plate, engraving, or other method by
15 which the poem "My Pledge" by Martin Treptow appears on the
16 monument. If more than one application is submitted, the
17 department, in consultation with the capitol planning commission,
18 shall approve the application that can best meet the requirements
19 for construction and maintenance of the site feature.

20 EXPLANATION

21 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
22 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

23 This bill requires the department of administrative services,
24 in consultation with the capitol planning commission, to
25 authorize the placement of a monument to Martin Treptow on the
26 capitol complex grounds. The bill requires the department to
27 solicit and approve an application for the monument, which must
28 include the poem "My Pledge" by Martin Treptow. If more than one
29 application is submitted, the department, in consultation with
30 the capitol planning commission, shall approve the application
31 that can best meet the requirements for construction and
32 maintenance of the monument.
