

Senate Study Bill 1125 - Introduced

A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the sharing of identifying information of
2 persons prohibited from acquiring a pistol or revolver by
3 court order.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. REPEAL. Section 724.31A, Code 2025, is repealed.

2 EXPLANATION

3 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
4 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

5 This bill relates to the sharing of identifying information of
6 persons prohibited from acquiring a pistol or revolver by court
7 order.

8 Under current Code section 724.31A, when a court issues an
9 order or judgment that prohibits a person from acquiring a pistol
10 or revolver, the clerk of the district court forwards information
11 necessary to identify the person to the department of public
12 safety (department), which in turn forwards the information
13 to the federal bureau of investigation for the sole purpose
14 of inclusion in the national instant criminal background check
15 system database. The clerk of the district court also notifies
16 the person of the prohibitions imposed.

17 When a person is no longer prohibited from acquiring a pistol
18 or revolver, the person may send a written request to inform
19 the department. The department then must correct, modify, or
20 remove the person's record in any database that the department
21 makes available to the national instant criminal background check
22 system and notify the United States department of justice that
23 the basis for such record being made available no longer applies.

24 The bill repeals Code section 724.31A.
