**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to fees for lifetime fur harvester licenses.  
2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 483A.24, subsection 17, Code 2026, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 17. Upon payment of a fee ~~established by rules adopted~~  
4 ~~pursuant to section 483A.1~~ of five dollars, and any processing  
5 fee, for a lifetime fur harvester license, the department shall  
6 issue a lifetime fur harvester license to a resident of Iowa who  
7 has served in the armed forces of the United States on federal  
8 active duty and who was disabled during that veteran's military  
9 service. The department shall prepare an application to be used  
10 by a person requesting a lifetime fur harvester license under  
11 this subsection. The department of veterans affairs shall assist  
12 the department in verifying the status or claims of applicants  
13 under this subsection. As used in this subsection, "disabled"  
14 means entitled to a service connected rating under 38 U.S.C.  
15 ch. 11.

16 EXPLANATION

17 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
18 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

19 This bill relates to fees for lifetime fur harvester licenses.  
20 Under current law, the fee for a lifetime fur harvester license  
21 is established by rule by the department of natural resources  
22 (DNR). The bill sets the fee at \$5, plus any additional  
23 processing fee.

24 Lifetime fur harvester licenses are currently available for  
25 purchase by residents of Iowa who served in the armed forces of  
26 the United States on federal active duty and who were disabled  
27 during military service.
