A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to voter records created and retained by the
2 state commissioner of elections.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 49.106 Records preserved.

2 1. Within sixty days of the conclusion of each election,
3 the state commissioner of elections shall create a record
4 containing all information in the statewide voter registration
5 database at the time of the election for each voter who voted
6 in the election, organized by county. The state commissioner
7 of elections shall maintain this record for eight years.

8 2. A record created pursuant to this section shall be made
9 available in an electronic format at no cost upon request,
10 except that if the record is too large to be transmitted
11 electronically, the requester shall provide a device to store
12 the record.

13 EXPLANATION

14 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
15 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

16 This bill requires the state commissioner of elections to
17 create a record containing all information in the statewide
18 voter registration database at the time of an election for
19 each voter who voted in that election, organized by county,
20 within 60 days after each election. The state commissioner of
21 elections shall maintain the record for eight years. A person
22 may request an electronic copy of the record at no cost.
