

Senate Study Bill 3095 - Introduced

A BILL FOR

1 An Act requiring annual reports on antisemitism in community
2 colleges, regents institutions, and public school districts.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 256.7, Code 2026, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 36. Submit to the general assembly and
4 governor, by October 1 of each year, a report identifying
5 each complaint or incident of antisemitism that occurred at
6 each community college, institution of higher education under
7 the control of the state board of regents, and public school
8 district from the prior academic year, and the findings and
9 outcomes of any investigations conducted, as reported by
10 each community college, institution of higher education, and
11 public school district. For the purposes of this subsection,
12 "*antisemitism*" means the same as defined in section 216F.1.

13 Sec. 2. Section 260C.14, Code 2026, is amended by adding the
14 following new subsection:

15 NEW SUBSECTION. 27. Annually, by September 1, submit to the
16 state board of education a report identifying each complaint or
17 incident of antisemitism that occurred at the community college
18 from the prior academic year, and the findings and outcomes of
19 any investigations conducted. For purposes of this subsection,
20 "*antisemitism*" means the same as defined in section 216F.1.

21 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. **262.93A Annual report on antisemitism.**

22 The state board of regents shall submit to the state board of
23 education, by September 1 of each year, a report identifying
24 each complaint or incident of antisemitism that occurred
25 at each of the institutions of higher education under the
26 control of the board from the prior academic year, and the
27 findings and outcomes of any investigations conducted. The
28 board shall conduct an annual review of the policies of the
29 regents institutions related to antisemitic actions and speech,
30 and provide the findings of such review in the report. For
31 purposes of this section, "*antisemitism*" means the same as
32 defined in section 216F.1.

33 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. **279.89 Annual report on antisemitism.**

34 The board of directors of each public school district shall
35 report annually to the state board of education, by September 1

1 of each year, a report identifying each complaint or incident
2 of antisemitism that occurred at the school district from
3 the prior academic year, and the findings and outcomes of
4 any investigations conducted. For purposes of this section,
5 "antisemitism" means the same as defined in section 216F.1.

EXPLANATION

The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
8 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

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9 This bill requires the state board of education to submit
10 an annual report to the general assembly and governor by
11 October 1 of each year, identifying each complaint or incident
12 of antisemitism that occurred during the prior academic year
13 at each community college, institution of higher education
14 under the control of the state board of regents, and public
15 school district. The bill requires the report to include the
16 findings and outcomes of any investigations conducted. The
17 bill requires the board of directors of each community college,
18 the state board of regents, and the board of directors of each
19 public school district to submit a report to the state board
20 of education by September 1 of each year identifying each
21 complaint or incident of antisemitism that occurred during the
22 prior academic year at the respective institution for use in
23 the state board of education's annual report.

24 The bill also requires the state board of regents to conduct
25 an annual review of policies related to antisemitic actions and
26 speech at regents institutions, and to include such findings
27 in the report.
