

**Senate Study Bill 3196 - Introduced**

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to salaries of state elected officials, and  
2 including applicability and future repeal provisions.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

DIVISION I

LEGISLATIVE SALARIES

3 Section 1. Section 2.10, subsections 1 and 2, Code 2026, are  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 1. Every member of the general assembly except the presiding  
6 officer of the senate, the speaker of the house, the majority  
7 and minority floor leader of each house, and the president pro  
8 tempore of the senate and speaker pro tempore of the house  
9 shall receive an annual salary of ~~twenty-five~~ thirty-seven  
10 thousand dollars for the ~~year 2007 and subsequent years~~ 2027  
11 through 2032 while serving as a member of the general assembly.  
12 For the year 2033 and subsequent years, every member of the  
13 general assembly except the presiding officer of the senate,  
14 the speaker of the house, the majority and minority floor  
15 leader of each house, and the president pro tempore of the  
16 senate and speaker pro tempore of the house shall receive an  
17 annual salary of twenty-five thousand dollars while serving  
18 as a member of the general assembly. In addition, each such  
19 member shall receive a per diem, as defined in subsection  
20 5, for expenses of office, except travel, for each day the  
21 general assembly is in session commencing with the first day  
22 of a legislative session and ending with the day of final  
23 adjournment of each legislative session as indicated by the  
24 journals of the house and senate, except that if the length  
25 of the first regular session of the general assembly exceeds  
26 one hundred ten calendar days and the second regular session  
27 exceeds one hundred calendar days, the payments shall be made  
28 only for one hundred ten calendar days for the first session  
29 and one hundred calendar days for the second session. Members  
30 from Polk county shall receive an amount per day equal to  
31 three-fourths of the per diem of the non-Polk county members.  
32 Each member shall receive a three hundred dollar per month  
33 allowance for legislative district constituency postage,  
34 travel, telephone costs, and other expenses. Travel expenses  
35 shall be paid at the rate established by [section 8A.363](#) for

1 actual travel in going to and returning from the seat of  
2 government by the nearest traveled route for not more than one  
3 time per week during a legislative session unless the general  
4 assembly otherwise provides.

5 2. a. The speaker of the house, the presiding officer  
6 of the senate, and the majority and minority floor leader of  
7 each house shall each receive an annual salary of ~~thirty-seven~~  
8 forty-nine thousand five hundred dollars for the ~~year 2007~~  
9 ~~and subsequent~~ years 2027 through 2032 while serving in that  
10 capacity. The president pro tempore of the senate and the  
11 speaker pro tempore of the house shall receive an annual salary  
12 of ~~twenty-seven~~ thirty-nine thousand dollars for the ~~year 2007~~  
13 ~~and subsequent~~ years 2027 through 2032 while serving in that  
14 capacity.

15 b. (1) For the year 2033 and subsequent years, the speaker  
16 of the house, the presiding officer of the senate, and the  
17 majority and minority floor leader of each house shall each  
18 receive an annual salary of thirty-seven thousand five hundred  
19 dollars while serving in that capacity.

20 (2) For the year 2033 and subsequent years, the president  
21 pro tempore of the senate and the speaker pro tempore of the  
22 house shall each receive an annual salary of twenty-seven  
23 thousand dollars while serving in that capacity.

24 c. Expense and travel allowances shall be the same for the  
25 speaker of the house and the presiding officer of the senate,  
26 the president pro tempore of the senate and the speaker pro  
27 tempore of the house, and the majority and minority leader  
28 of each house as provided for other members of the general  
29 assembly.

30 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This division of this Act applies  
31 upon the convening of the Ninety-second General Assembly in  
32 January 2027.

33 DIVISION II

34 SALARIES OF STATEWIDE ELECTIVE EXECUTIVE OFFICIALS

35 Sec. 3. ELECTIVE EXECUTIVE OFFICIALS — SALARIES.

1 1. The annual salary rates specified in this section are  
2 effective for the pay period beginning January 1, 2027, for the  
3 remainder of the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, and for  
4 subsequent fiscal years until otherwise provided by the general  
5 assembly. The salaries provided for in this section shall  
6 be paid from moneys appropriated to the department or office  
7 specified in this section pursuant to any Act of the general  
8 assembly.

9 2. The following annual salary rates shall be paid to the  
10 person holding the position indicated:

11 a. OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

12 (1) Salary for the governor:

13 ..... \$ 142,000

14 (2) Salary for the lieutenant governor:

15 ..... \$ 115,212

16 b. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND LAND STEWARDSHIP

17 Salary for the secretary of agriculture:

18 ..... \$ 115,212

19 c. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

20 Salary for the attorney general:

21 ..... \$ 135,669

22 d. OFFICE OF THE AUDITOR OF STATE

23 Salary for the auditor of state:

24 ..... \$ 115,212

25 e. OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE

26 Salary for the secretary of state:

27 ..... \$ 115,212

28 f. OFFICE OF THE TREASURER OF STATE

29 Salary for the treasurer of state:

30 ..... \$ 115,212

31 3. This section is repealed December 31, 2032. On that  
32 date, the annual salaries for the officials specified in this  
33 section shall be as provided in 2005 Iowa Acts, chapter 177,  
34 section 2.

EXPLANATION

1           The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
2           the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

3           This bill relates to salaries of state elected officials.

4           DIVISION I — LEGISLATIVE SALARIES. The bill increases  
5 the salaries for members of the general assembly, including  
6 specified officers, by \$12,000 for the years 2027 through  
7 2032. For the year 2033 and subsequent years, the bill reverts  
8 the salaries for members of the general assembly, including  
9 specified officers, to the amounts specified in the 2026 Iowa  
10 Code. Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Iowa,  
11 this division applies upon the convening of the 92nd General  
12 Assembly in January 2027.

13          DIVISION II — SALARIES OF STATEWIDE ELECTIVE EXECUTIVE  
14 OFFICIALS. The bill increases the salaries of the governor,  
15 lieutenant governor, secretary of agriculture, attorney  
16 general, auditor of state, secretary of state, and treasurer of  
17 state by \$12,000 beginning January 1, 2027, and for subsequent  
18 fiscal years. This provision of the bill is repealed December  
19 31, 2032. On that date, the annual salaries for such officials  
20 shall be as provided in 2005 Iowa Acts, chapter 177, section 2.
