Section 1. NEW SECTION. 268.6 IOWA STUDIES == 2 LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS == CURRICULUM == COMMITTEE.

1. The general assembly finds that Iowa students should 4 have an appreciation for Iowa through the study of Iowa's 5 history and government, and Iowa citizens' long and 6 distinguished record of civic responsibility. There is a fundamental need for Iowa's students to be provided with 8 learning opportunities that assist the students to succeed in 9 society and confer upon them the ability to make their own

10 valuable contributions to Iowa's history.
11 2. The university of northern Iowa, in cooperation with 1 12 the community colleges and area education agencies, shall 13 develop an Iowa studies professional development plan that

14 shall include professional development materials and training 1 15 measures to provide Iowa's teachers with effective ways to 1 16 infuse Iowa studies into their classrooms. The materials 17 developed shall include an active and innovative Iowa studies 18 learning curriculum that may be integrated into the social 1 19 studies requirements for Iowa's secondary students at the

20 discretion of each board of directors of a school district or 21 the authorities in charge of each accredited nonpublic school. 1 22 The curriculum shall include lesson plans covering Iowa 23 history, civics, Iowa government, and Iowa heritage studies.

24 The curriculum developed shall be at least one=half of a unit

1 25 of credit. 1 26

- 3. a. The dean of the college of education at the 27 university, in cooperation with the community colleges and 28 area education agencies, shall establish an Iowa studies 1 29 committee to do the following:
- 30 Work to inform Iowa's accredited schools and area (1)31 education agencies of the Iowa studies professional 1 32 development plan, including how to effectively utilize the 33 curriculum developed pursuant to subsection 2.

34 (2) Develop partnerships with organizations such as 35 nonprofit history or humanities organizations, civic 1 organizations, libraries, and the business community to 2 support and promote Iowa studies statewide.

Establish evaluation criteria for the Iowa studies 4 professional development plan, including but not limited to 5 teacher and student evaluation, student tracking, and 6 curriculum and plan effectiveness, which may include a survey 7 of student participation in civic activities and involvement 8 in the election process.

9 (4) Develop a strategy and plan to allow for the 10 implementation of the professional development plan and 11 curriculum in a limited number of area education agencies and 2 12 schools across the state. Participation by an area education 2 13 agency or school shall be voluntary. However, an area 2 14 education agency or school requesting and selected to 15 participate in the plan shall agree to participate in the 16 evaluation component conducted by the department of education 2 17 pursuant to subsection 4.

The committee membership shall be comprised of the 2 19 following:

- 2 20 (1)The dean of the college of education or the dean's 2 21 designee. 2 22
 - The secretary of state or the secretary's designee. (2)
- (3) The administrator of an area education agency or the 23 2 24 administrator's designee.
- 2 25 (4) The director of the department of education or the 2 26 director's designee.
- 2 27 (5) The director of the department of cultural affairs, or 28 the director's designee. 29
 - (6) The state librarian, or the state librarian's designee.
- (5) An individual employed as an Iowa social studies 2 32 teacher at an accredited school.
 - (6) An individual employed by the community colleges.(7) A member of the Iowa council of social studies.
 - 4.
 - The department of education, in cooperation with the 1 Iowa studies committee, shall do the following:
 - a. Conduct an evaluation of the Iowa studies professional 3 development plan using the evaluation criteria established by 4 the committee.
 - Submit, until June 30, 2007, an annual status report on b. 6 the utilization of the Iowa studies professional development 7 plan in Iowa's accredited schools to the chairpersons and 8 ranking members of the senate and house committees on 9 education by January 15. The annual report shall include the 10 number of schools utilizing the plan.
- 3 c. Submit its findings and recommendations in a final 11 12 report based upon the evaluation data compiled in accordance 3 13 with subsection 3 to the chairpersons and ranking members of 3 14 the senate and house committees on education by January 15, 15 2008.
