- 26 1. An applicant for a license as a used motor vehicle 27 dealer shall complete a minimum of eight hours of prelicensing 1 28 education program courses pursuant to this section prior to 29 submitting an application to the department.
- 2. A person seeking renewal of a used motor vehicle dealer 1 31 license shall complete a minimum of five hours of continuing 32 education program courses over a two=year period pursuant to 33 this section prior to submitting an application for license 34 renewal. However, an applicant for renewal of a used motor 35 vehicle dealer license who has met the prelicensing education 1 requirement under subsection 1 within the preceding twelve months is exempt from the continuing education requirement for 3 license renewal.
 - 3. To meet the requirements of this section, at least one individual who is associated with the used motor vehicle 5 6 dealer as an owner, principal, corporate officer, director, or 7 member or partner of a limited liability company or limited 8 liability partnership shall complete the education program 9 courses.

The Iowa independent auto dealers association, in 2 11 consultation with the state department of transportation, the 12 department of education, the attorney general, and the Iowa 13 association of community college trustees, shall develop the 14 prelicensing and continuing education course curricula for the 2 15 used motor vehicle dealer education program, which shall 2 16 include but not be limited to examination of federal and state 2 17 laws applicable to the motor vehicle industry and federal, 2 18 state, and local regulations pertaining to used motor vehicle
