A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to an appropriation from the environment first fund for the establishment of permanent soil and water conservation practices, by allocating moneys to support the administration of local governmental units, and providing an effective date. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: TLSB 1562SV 81 8 da/sh/8

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Section 1. NEW SECTION. 170.3A CHRONIC WASTING DISEASE
2 CONTROL PROGRAM == FEES.
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- 1. The department shall establish and administer a chronic 4 wasting disease control program for the control of chronic 5 wasting disease which threatens farm deer. The program may 6 include procedures for the inspection and testing of farm 7 deer, responses to reported cases of chronic wasting disease, 8 and methods to ensure that owners of farm deer may engage in 9 the movement and sale of farm deer.
- 2. Beginning on July 1, 2006, a chronic wasting disease 1 10 11 control fee is imposed on landowners who maintain farm deer in 12 this state. The fee shall be established by rules adopted by 1 13 the department in an amount which will generate total revenue 1 14 not exceeding an amount which is reasonable and necessary to 1 15 administer the chronic wasting disease control program.
- NEW SECTION. 170.3B FARM DEER ADMINISTRATION Sec. 2. 1 17 FUND == APPROPRIATION.
- 1 18 1. A farm deer administration fund is created in the state 1 19 treasury under the control of the department. The fund is 1 20 composed of moneys appropriated by the general assembly and 21 moneys available to and obtained or accepted by the department 22 from the United States or private sources for placement in the 1 23 fund. The fund shall include all moneys collected from the 24 chronic wasting disease control fee as provided in section 25 170.3A. The moneys in the fund are appropriated exclusively 1 26 to the department for purposes of administering the chronic 1 27 wasting disease control program as provided in section 170.3A.
- 28 2. Moneys in the fund are subject to an annual audit by 29 the auditor of state. The fund is subject to warrants written 1 1 30 by the director of the department of administrative services, 1 31 drawn upon the written requisition of the department.
- 32 3. Section 8.33 shall not apply to moneys in the fund. 33 Notwithstanding section 12C.7, moneys earned as income or 1 34 interest from the fund shall remain in the fund until expended 35 as provided in this section.
- Sec. 3. 2004 Iowa Acts, chapter 1175, section 301, 2 2 subsection 1, paragraph f, unnumbered paragraph 2, is amended 2 3 to read as follows:
 - 4 (1) Not more than 5 percent of the moneys appropriated in 5 this lettered paragraph "f" may be used for costs of 6 administration and implementation of soil and water conservation practices.
- (2) Of the amount appropriated in this paragraph "f", \$250,000 shall be used to reimburse commissioners of soil and
- 10 water conservation districts for administrative expenses, 11 including, but not limited to, travel expenses, technical
- 12 training, and professional dues.
- Of the amount appropriated in this paragraph "f",

2 14 \$127,000 shall be deposited into the farm deer administration
2 15 fund created in section 170.3B for purposes of administering
2 16 the chronic wasting disease control program as provided in
2 17 section 170.3A.
2 18 Sec. 4. DEPARTMENT == PAYMENT OF REIMBURSEMENT MONEYS.
2 19 The department of agriculture and land stewardship shall
2 20 reimburse commissioners of soil and water conservation
2 11 districts the amounts allocated pursuant to section 1 of this
2 12 Act within ten days after the effective date of this Act.
2 23 Sec. 5. REPORTING. A soil and water conservation district
2 24 receiving moneys from an allocation provided in this Act shall
2 25 submit a report to the soil conservation division of the
2 26 department of agriculture and land stewardship by January 1,
2 27 2006, accounting for moneys which have been expended or
2 28 unexpended or which have been obligated or encumbered. The
2 29 report shall state how the moneys were used.
2 30 Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
3 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
