## A BILL FOR

| 1 | An Act concerning existing and new special motor vehicle |
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| 2 | registration plates associated with military service, |
| 3 | crediting fees from the sale of certain special motor vehicle |
| 4 | registration plates to the emergency medical services fund and |
| 5 | the veterans license fee fund, and providing effective dates. |

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registration fee of fifteen dollars. The department shall 16 validate the special plates in the same manner as regular 17 registration plates are validated under this section. The 18 department shall not issue special registration plates until 19 service organizations in the state have furnished the 20 department either the special dies or the cost of the special 21 dies necessary for the manufacture of the special registration 22 plate.
The surviving spouse of a person who was issued special plates under this subsection may continue to use the special plates subject to registration of the special plates in the surviving spouse's name and upon payment of the fifteen dollar annual registration fee. If the surviving spouse remarries, the surviving spouse shall return the special plates to the department and the department shall issue regular registration plates to the surviving spouse.
Sec. 3. Section 321.34, subsection 10A, Code 2007, is amended to read as follows:
10A. EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PLATES.
a. The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration pursuant to section 321.109 , subsection 1 , motor truck, motor home, multipurpose vehicle, motorcycle, trailer, or travel trailer referred to in subsection 12 who is a current member of a paid or volunteer emergency medical services agency may, upon written application to the department, order special registration plates, designed by the department in cooperation with representatives designated by the Iowa emergency medical
services association, which plates signify that the applicant
is a current member of a paid or volunteer emergency medical
services agency. The application shall be approved by the
department, in consultation with representatives designated by
the Iowa emergency medical services association, and the
special registration plates shall be issued to the applicant
in exchange for the registration plates previously issued to
the person. The fee for the special plates shall be is
twenty=five dollars which shall be is in addition to the
regular annual registration fee. The department shall
validate the special plates in the same manner as regular
registration plates are validated under this section at the
regular annual registration fee.
b. The special fees collected by the director under this
subsection shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of state and
credited to the road use tax fund. Notwithstanding section
423.43, and prior to the crediting of revenues to the road use
tax fund under section 423.43, subsection 1, paragraph "b",
the treasurer of state shall transfer monthly from those
revenues to the emergency medical services fund created in
section 135.25 the amount of the special fees collected in the
previous month for issuance of emergency medical services
plates.
Sec. 4. Section 321.34, subsections 12A, 16, 17, 18, 19,
and 20, code 2007, are amended to read as follows:
12A. SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES == ARMED FORCES SERVICES.
a. An owner of a vehicle referred to in subsection 12 who
applies for any type of special registration plates associated
with service in the United States armed forces shall be issued
one set of the special registration plates at no charge, but
shall be subject to the annual registration fee of fifteen
dollars, if all of the following conditions are met:
a. (1) The owner is eligible for, but has relinquished to
the department or the county treasurer or has not been issued,
congressionat medal of honor, ex=prisoner of war, or legion of
merit special registration plates under this section, or
disabled veteran registration plates under section 321.105.
b. (2) The owner provides the appropriate information
regarding the owner's eligibility for any of the special
registration plates described in paragraph "a", and regarding
the owner's eligibility for the special regist'ration plates
for which the owner has applied, as required by the
department.
b. A disabled veteran shall be exempt from payment of the
fifteen dollar annual registration fee as provided in section
321.105.
Upon the death of the vehicle owner entitled to the special
registration plates, the special registration plates shall be
surrendered to the department or the county treasurer.
c. The surviving spouse of a person who was issued special
plates under this subsection may continue to use the special
plates subject to registration of the special plates in the
surviving spouse's name and upon payment of the same annual
registration fee. If the surviving spouse remarries, the
surviving spouse shall return the special plates to the department and the department shall issue regular registration 28 plates to the surviving spouse.
29 16. NATIONAL GUARD SPECIAL PLATES. An owner referred to 30 in subsection 12 who is a member of the national guard, as 31 defined in chapter 29A, may, upon written application to the 32 department, order special registration plates with a national 33 guard processed emblem with the emblem designed by the 34 department in cooperation with the adjutant general which 35 emblem signifies that the applicant is a member of the 1 national guard. The application shall be approved by the 2 department in consultation with the adjutant general. The 3 special plate fees collected by the director under subsection 4 12, paragraph ${ }^{\text {a }}$, from the issuance and annual validation of 5 letter=number designated and personalized national guard
6 plates shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of state and
credited to the road use tax fund. Notwithstanding section
423.43, and prior to the crediting of revenues to the road use
9 tax fund under section 423.43, subsection 1, paragraph "b",
10 the treasurer of state shall transfer monthly from those
11 revenues to the veterans license fee fund created in section
12 35A. 11 the amount of the special fees collected in the
13 previous month for national guard plates. Special
514 registration plates with a national guard processed emblem
15 shall be surrendered, as provided in subsection 12 , in
516 exchange for regular registration plates upon termination of
17 the owner's membership in the active national guard.
18 The surviving spouse of a person who was issued special
20 and use the special plates subject to registration of the
special plates in the surviving spouse's name and upon payment
of the annual five=dollar special plate fee and the regular
annual registration fee for the vehicle. If the surviving
spouse remarries, the surviving spouse shall return the
special plates to the department and the department shall

17. PEARL HARBOR SPECIAL PLATES. An owner referred to in
subsection 12 who was at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, as a member of

30 may, upon written application to the department, order special
31 registration plates with a Pearl Harbor processed emblem. The
32 emblem shall be designed by the department in consultation
33 with service organizations. The application is subject to
approval by the department. The special plate fees collected
by the director under subsection 12, paragraph "a", from the
issuance and annual validation of letter=number designated and
personalized Pearl Harbor plates shall be paid monthly to the
treasurer of state and credited to the road use tax fund.
Notwithstanding section 423.43, and prior to the crediting of
revenues to the road use tax fund under section 423.43 ,
subsection 1, paragraph "b", the treasurer of state shall
transfer monthly from those revenues to the veterans license
fee fund created in section 35A. 11 the amount of the special
fees collected in the previous month for Pearl Harbor plates.
10 The surviving spouse of a person who was issued special
612 and use the special plates subject to registration of the
13 special plates in the surviving spouse's name and upon payment
614 of the annual five=dollar special plate fee and the regular
615 annual registration fee for the vehicle. If the surviving
616 spouse remarries, the surviving spouse shall return the

25 order special registration plates with a purple heart
26 processed emblem. The design of the emblem shall include a
67 representation of a purple heart medal and ribbon. The
28 application is subject to approval by the department in
629 consultation with the adjutant general. The special plate
630 fees collected by the director under subsection 12, paragraph
631 "a", from the issuance and annual validation of letter=number
632 designated and personalized purple heart plates shall be paid
633 monthly to the treasurer of state and credited to the road use
634 tax fund. Notwithstanding section 423.43, and prior to the
635 crediting of revenues to the road use tax fund under section

NEW SUBSECTION. 20B. SOLDIER'S, NAVY AND MARINE CORPS, OR AIRMAN'S MEDAL PLATES. An owner referred to in subsection 12 who was awarded a soldier's medal, a navy and marine corps medal, or an airman's medal by the United States government may, upon written application to the department and presentation of satisfactory proof of the award, order special registration plates with a soldier's medal, navy and marine corps medal, or airman's medal processed emblem. The emblem shall be designed by the department in consultation with the adjutant general. The special plate fees collected by the director under subsection 12, paragraph "a", from the issuance and annual validation of letter=number designated and personalized soldier's medal, navy and marine corps medal, and airman's medal plates shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of state and credited to the road use tax fund. Notwithstanding section 423.43 , and prior to the crediting of revenues to the road use tax fund under section 423.43, subsection 1, paragraph "b", the treasurer of state shall transfer monthly from those revenues to the veterans license fee fund created in section 35A. 11 the amount of the special fees collected in the previous month for soldier's medal, navy and marine corps medal, and airman's medal plates.

The surviving spouse of a person who was issued special plates under this subsection may continue to use or apply for and use the special plates subject to registration of the special plates in the surviving spouse's name and upon payment of the annual five=dollar special plate fee and the regular annual registration fee for the vehicle. If the surviving spouse remarries, the surviving spouse shall return the special plates to the department and the department shall issue regular registration plates to the surviving spouse.

Sec. 6 . Section 321.166 , subsections 2 and 9, Code 2007, are amended to read as follows:
2. Every registration plate or pair of plates shall display a registration plate number which shall consist of alphabetical or numerical characters or a combination thereof and the name of this state, which may be abbreviated. Every registration plate issued by the county treasurer shall display the name of the county, including any plate issued pursuant to section 321.34, except Pearl Harbor and purple heart registration plates issued prior to January 1, 1997, and collegiate, fire fighter, and eongressional medal of honor registration plates. Special truck registration plates shall display the word "special".
9. Special registration plates issued pursuant to section 321.34 beginning January 1, 1997, other than eongressional medal of honor, collegiate, fire' fighter, and natural resources registration plates, shall be consistent with the design and color of regular registration plates but shall provide a space on a portion of the plate for the purpose of allowing the placement of a distinguishing processed emblem. Special registration plates shall also comply with the requirements for regular registration plates as provided in this section to the extent the requirements are consistent with the section authorizing a particular special vehicle registration plate.
