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1	1 Section 1. Section 169C.1, Code 2007, is amended by adding
	2 the following new subsections:

2 the following new subsections: 3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 1A. "Fence" means a fence as described in 4 chapter 359A which is lawful and tight as provided in that 5 chapter, including but not limited to a partition fence. For 6 purposes of this chapter, "fence" includes a fence bordering a 1 1 1 1 1 7 public road. NEW SUBSECTION. 8. "Public road" means a thoroughfare and 1 8 9 its right=of=way, whether reserved by public ownership or
10 easement, for use by the traveling public.
11 Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 169C.6 HABITUAL TRESPASS.
12 A habitual trespass occurs when livestock trespasses from 1 1 1 11 1 12 1 13 the land where the livestock are kept onto the land of a 1 14 neighboring landowner or strays from the land where the 1 15 livestock are kept onto a public road, and on three or more 1 16 separate occasions within the prior twelve=month period the 1 17 same or different livestock kept on that land have trespassed 1 18 onto the land of the same neighboring landowner or strayed 1 19 from the land where the livestock are kept on the same public 1 20 road. 1 21 1. The local authority upon its own initiative or upon 1 22 receipt of a complaint shall determine whether livestock are 1 23 trespassing or straying from the land where the livestock are 1 24 kept on a public road, and make a record of its findings. 1 25 2. a. Once a habitual trespass occurs, a neighboring 1 26 landowner may request that the responsible landowner of the 27 land where the trespassing or stray livestock are kept erect 28 or maintain a fence on the land. The neighboring landowner 1 1 1 29 shall make the request to the responsible landowner in 1 30 writing. The responsible landowner may compel an adjacent 1 31 landowner to contribute to the erection or maintenance of the 1 32 fence as provided in chapter 359A. 1 33 b. If the responsible landowner does not erect or maintain 34 a fence within thirty days after receiving the request, the 35 neighboring landowner may apply to the fence viewers as 1 provided in chapter 359A as if the matter were a controversy 1 1 2 2 2 between the responsible landowner and an adjacent landowner, 3 and the matter shall be resolved by an order issued by the 4 fence viewers, subject to appeal, as provided in chapter 359A. 2 2 2 5 The neighboring landowner shall be a party to the controversy 6 as if the neighboring party were an adjacent landowner. The 7 neighboring landowner is not liable for erecting or 2 2 2 8 maintaining the fence, unless the neighboring landowner is an 2 9 adjacent landowner who is otherwise required to make a 2 10 contribution under chapter 359A. 3. If the fence is not erected or maintained as required 2 11 2 12 in section 359A.6, and upon the written request of the board 2 13 of township trustees, the board of supervisors of the county 2 14 where the fence is to be erected or maintained shall act in 2 15 the same manner as the board of township trustees under that

2 16 section, including by erecting or maintaining the fence,

2 17 ordering payment from a defaulted party, and certifying an 2 18 amount due to the county auditor. The amount due shall 2 19 include the total costs required to erect or maintain the 2 20 fence and a penalty equal to five percent of the total costs. 2 21 The amount shall be placed upon the tax books, and collected 2 22 with interest and penalties after due, in the same manner as 2 3 other unpaid property taxes. 2 4 Sec. 3. <u>NEW SECTION.</u> 359A.22A HABITUAL TRESPASS. 2 5 A landowner of land where livestock are kept or an owner of 2 6 adjoining land shall be liable to erect or maintain a fence if 2 7 the livestock trespasses upon the land of a neighboring 2 8 landowner or strays from the land where the livestock are kept 2 9 onto a public road, as provided in section 169C.6. 2 30 SF 200 2 31 da:nh/cc/26
