For filing an application for the license to marry, 8 thirty=five dollars, which includes payment for one certified 9 copy of the original certificate of marriage, Out of this 10 amount, the county shall retain its fee, pursuant to 11 subsection 6, for a certified copy of a marriage certificate 12 to be issued following filing of the original certificate of 13 marriage, four dollars of which shall be retained by the 14 county pursuant to subsection 6.
