Section 15E.175, subsection 1, Code 2007, is 1 2 amended by striking the subsection and inserting in lieu 3 thereof the following: 1. The department shall establish a physical infrastructure financial assistance program to provide 1 6 financial assistance for business or community physical 1 7 infrastructure development or redevelopment projects. 8 Physical infrastructure development or redevelopment projects 9 include but are not limited to infrastructure projects 1 10 involving any mode of transportation; public works and
1 11 utilities such as sewer, water, power, or telecommunications;
1 12 physical improvements which mitigate, prevent, or eliminate 1 13 environmental contaminants; and any other project deemed 1 14 appropriate by the department.
1 15 a. Physical infrastructure projects that create the 1 16 necessary infrastructure for economic success throughout Iowa, 1 17 that provide the foundation for the creation of quality, 1 18 high-wage jobs, and that involve substantial capital 1 19 investment may be eligible for financial assistance under the 1 20 program if within three years of the completion of the 1 21 project, the project meets certain performance measurements 1 22 established by the department. The performance measurements 1 23 may include but are not limited to a requirement for building 1 24 infrastructure projects involving tenant businesses that the 1 25 tenant businesses meet minimum job and wage requirements 1 26 pursuant to section 15G.112. If, at the end of the three=year 1 27 period, the project has not met the performance measurements 1 28 established by the department, the department may seek to 1 29 reclaim any funds granted through the program. At the 1 30 department's discretion, a project may be granted an 1 31 additional year of time to meet the performance measurements 1 32 of this subsection. b. The department shall adopt rules governing the awarding 34 and use of funds pursuant to this section.

(f) The loan and credit guarantee program established 3 13 14 pursuant to section 15E.224. 3 15 Sec. 3. Section 15G.111, Code 2007, is amended by adding 3 16 the following new subsection: NEW SUBSECTION. 8A. For the fiscal period beginning July 3 17 3 18 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2015, from the moneys 3 19 appropriated each fiscal year from the grow Iowa values fund 3 20 created in section 15G.108, to the department for program 3 21 administration pursuant to subsection 1, paragraph "a", the 22 department may allocate up to five million dollars to projects 23 qualifying for assistance under the physical infrastructure 24 financial assistance program established pursuant to section 25 15E.175 which, notwithstanding section 15G.112, shall not be 26 subject to job or wage requirements. The department may 27 allocate moneys from the grow Iowa values fund above five 28 million dollars each year to projects qualifying for 29 assistance under the physical infrastructure financial 3 30 assistance program but such projects shall be subject to the 3 31 job and wage requirements of section 15G.112. 32 Sec. 4. Section 15G.112, subsections 1 and 3, Code 2007, 33 are amended to read as follows: 3 1. In order to be eligible to receive financial assistance 3 35 from the department from the moneys appropriated in section 1 15G.111, subsection 1, paragraph "a", from the grow Iowa 2 values fund to the department for programs administered by 3 department, the average annual wage, including benefits, of 4 4 new jobs created must be equal to or greater than one hundred 5 thirty percent of the average county wage. For purposes of 6 this section, "average county wage" and "benefits" mean the 4 7 same as defined in section 15I.1. 8 3. In awarding moneys appropriated to the department 4 9 pursuant to section 15G.111, subsection 1, paragraph "a", 14 10 the grow Iowa values fund for programs administered by the 4 11 department, the department shall give special consideration to 4 12 projects that include significant physical infrastructure
