- 1 An Act providing veterans a holiday for veterans day and making
- penalties applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **91A.5A** Holiday time off Veterans 2 Day.
- An employer shall provide each employee who is a veteran,
- 4 as defined in section 35.1, with holiday time off for Veterans
- 5 Day, November 11, if the employee would otherwise be required
- 6 to work on that day, as provided in this section.
- 7 2. An employer, in complying with this section, shall have
- 8 the discretion of providing paid or unpaid time off on Veterans
- 9 Day.
- 3. An employee shall provide the employer with at least one
- 11 month's prior written notice of the employee's intent to take
- 12 time off for Veterans Day and shall also provide the employer
- 13 with a federal certificate of release or discharge from
- 14 active duty, or such similar federal document, for purposes of
- 15 determining the employee's eligibility for the benefit provided
- 16 in this section.
