A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing an Iowa communications network advisory
- 2 committee.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. IOWA COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK ADVISORY
 2 COMMITTEE.
- 3 1. An Iowa communications network advisory committee is
- 4 established to study and make recommendations to the governor
- 5 and the general assembly regarding the current and future
- 6 operation of the Iowa communications network. Aspects of the
- 7 study shall include the following:
- 8 a. Current usage level and capacity of the network.
- 9 b. Current and anticipated future operating and maintenance 10 expenses.
- 11 c. Options for expanding network access to public and
- 12 private users.
- d. Options for forming public and private partnerships with
- 14 regard to ownership and operation of the network.
- 15 e. Leasing arrangements.
- 16 f. Current and anticipated future network revenue.
- 17 g. Current status of the network from a technological
- 18 standpoint and future plans and modifications to the network in
- 19 response to anticipated technological advancements.
- 20 2. a. The committee shall be comprised of the following
- 21 voting members who shall be appointed by the governor:
- 22 (1) One member representing the Iowa telecommunications and
- 23 technology commission.
- 24 (2) One member representing the Iowa utilities board.
- 25 (3) One member representing the department of economic
- 26 development.
- 27 (4) One member representing the department of education.
- 28 (5) One member representing state agency users of the
- 29 network not otherwise designated pursuant to this section.
- 30 (6) One member representing area education agencies.
- 31 (7) One member representing the office of the attorney
- 32 general.
- 33 (8) One member representing the Iowa state association of
- 34 counties.
- 35 (9) One member representing the Iowa league of cities.

- 1 (10) One member representing the Iowa association of school
- 2 boards.
- 3 (11) One member representing the wired telecommunications
- 4 industry.
- 5 (12) One member representing the wireless
- 6 telecommunications industry.
- 7 (13) One member representing a municipal utility providing
- 8 telecommunications services.
- 9 (14) One member representing the cable television industry.
- 10 (15) Three members representing the general public.
- 11 b. The committee shall be comprised of the following
- 12 nonvoting, ex officio members:
- 13 (1) One representative to be appointed by the speaker of the
- 14 house of representatives, one representative to be appointed
- 15 by the minority leader of the house of representatives, one
- 16 senator to be appointed by the president of the senate after
- 17 consultation with the majority leader of the senate, and one
- 18 senator to be appointed by the minority leader of the senate.
- 19 (2) One member representing the governor's office,
- 20 appointed by the governor.
- 3. a. Sections 69.16 and 69.16A shall apply to the public
- 22 members of the board.
- 23 b. Public members may be eligible to receive compensation
- 24 as provided in section 7E.6. Members shall be reimbursed for
- 25 actual and necessary expenses incurred in performance of the
- 26 members' duties.
- 27 c. The committee shall elect a chair and a vice chair from
- 28 among the voting members of the board, by majority vote. A
- 29 majority of the members of the board shall constitute a quorum.
- 30 d. Staffing assistance shall be provided by the Iowa
- 31 telecommunications and technology commission.
- 32 4. The committee shall submit a report summarizing the
- 33 results of the study and making recommendations to the governor
- 34 and the general assembly by December 31, 2010.
