- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 537A.6 In-state construction
- 2 contracts Iowa law to govern.
- 3 1. As used in this section, "in-state construction
- 4 contract means a public, private, foreign, or domestic
- 5 agreement relating to construction, alteration, repair, or
- 6 maintenance of any real property in this state and includes
- 7 agreements for architectural services, demolition, design
- 8 services, development, engineering services, excavation, or any
- 9 other improvement to real property in this state, including
- 10 buildings, shafts, wells, and structures, whether on, above,
- ll or under real property in this state. "In-state construction
- 12 contract does not include any agreement between this state and
- 13 any other state.
- 2. A provision of an in-state construction contract is void
- 15 and unenforceable as contrary to public policy if the provision
- 16 does any of the following:
- 17 a. Makes the in-state construction contract subject to the
- 18 laws of another state.
- 19 b. Requires any litigation, mediation, arbitration, or
- 20 other dispute resolution proceeding arising from the in-state
- 21 construction contract to be conducted in another state.
- 22 3. Notwithstanding any contractual provision to the
- 23 contrary, the laws of this state shall apply to every in-state
- 24 construction contract.
- 25 4. Any litigation, mediation, arbitration, or other dispute
- 26 resolution proceeding arising from or relating to an in-state
- 27 construction contract shall be conducted in this state.
- 28 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect January 1,
- 29 2014.
