A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to public cafeterias concerning local
2 purchasing preferences and the American heart association's
3 dietary guidelines.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. PUBLIC CAFETERIAS — PURCHASING PREFERENCES AND
2 DIETARY GUIDELINES.

3 1. The department of administrative services, in
4 collaboration with the department of public health and the
5 department of agriculture and land stewardship, shall convene a
6 task force to propose a procurement policy and implementation
7 timeline for the policy requiring all cafeterias at the capitol
8 complex and buildings in this state in which an executive
9 branch agency has an office to conform to the American heart
10 association's procurement standards or the United States
11 department of health and human services' guidelines for federal
12 concessions and vending operations, and to establish purchasing
13 preferences for local producers of food and local beverage
14 providers.

15 2. The state board of regents and the department of
16 education, in collaboration with the department of agriculture
17 and land stewardship, shall also convene a task force to
18 propose a procurement policy and implementation timeline for
19 the policy requiring collegiate campus cafeterias to conform
20 to the American heart association's procurement standards or
21 the United States department of health and human services'
22 guidelines for federal concessions and vending operations, and
23 to establish purchasing preferences for local producers of food
24 and local beverage providers. Campus cafeterias addressed in
25 the policy include cafeterias located at the university of
26 northern Iowa, Iowa state university, the university of Iowa,
27 and all community colleges.

28 3. The task forces shall submit their procurement policies
29 and implementation timelines to the general assembly by January
30 2, 2014.

31 4. The department of administrative services, state board
32 of regents, and department of education shall each adopt a
33 procurement policy requiring the affected cafeterias to conform
34 to the American heart association's procurement standards or
35 the United States department of health and human services'

1 guidelines for federal concessions and vending operations by
2 January 1, 2015.

3 5. The department of administrative services and the
4 department of public health shall review and update relevant
5 nutrition standards every five years, starting in 2018, to
6 reflect advancements in nutrition science, dietary data, and
7 food product availability.

8 6. Any affected cafeteria's new or renewal food service
9 contract entered into during calendar year 2014 shall also
10 conform to the appropriate procurement policies adopted
11 pursuant to subsection 4.
