- 1 Section 1. Section 633.635, subsection 1, Code 2015, is
- 2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 3 NEW PARAGRAPH. Of. Placing reasonable time, place,
- 4 or manner restrictions on communication, visitation, or
- 5 interaction between the ward and another person.
- 6 Sec. 2. Section 633.635, subsection 2, Code 2015, is amended
- 7 by adding the following new paragraph:
- 8 NEW PARAGRAPH. d. Denying all communication, visitation, or
- 9 interaction by an adult ward with a person with whom the adult
- 10 ward has expressed a desire to communicate, visit, or interact
- 11 or with a person who seeks to communicate, visit, or interact
- 12 with the adult ward. A court shall approve the denial of all
- 13 communication, visitation, or interaction with another person
- 14 only upon a showing of good cause by the guardian.
- 15 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 633.637A Rights of ward under
- 16 guardianship.
- 17 An adult ward under a guardianship has the right of
- 18 communication, visitation, or interaction with other persons
- 19 upon the consent of the adult ward, subject to section 633.635,
- 20 subsection 1, paragraph "0f", and section 633.635, subsection
- 21 2, paragraph "d". If an adult ward is unable to give express
- 22 consent to such communication, visitation, or interaction with
- 23 a person due to a physical or mental condition, consent of a
- 24 ward may be presumed by a guardian or a court based on a ward's
- 25 prior relationship with such person.
