A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the enforcement of motor vehicle laws and
- 2 the regulation of commercial motor vehicles and certain
- 3 operators by the department of transportation, and including
- 4 effective date provisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.180, subsection 2, paragraph c, Code 2 2017, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 c. A commercial learner's permit shall be valid for a period
- 4 not to exceed one hundred eighty days the period provided in
- 5 49 C.F.R. §383.25(c) and 49 C.F.R. §383.73(a)(2)(iii). A
- 6 commercial learner's permit may be renewed for an additional
- 7 one hundred eighty days without retaking the general and
- 8 endorsement knowledge tests required by section 321.188.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 321.463, Code 2017, is amended by adding the
- 10 following new subsection:
- 11 NEW SUBSECTION. 4A. a. Notwithstanding any provision of
- 12 law to the contrary, a motor vehicle equipped with an engine
- 13 fueled primarily by natural gas may exceed any applicable
- 14 maximum gross weight limit under this chapter, up to a maximum
- 15 gross weight of eighty-two thousand pounds, by an amount
- 16 equal to the difference between the weight of the vehicle
- 17 attributable to the natural gas tank and fueling system
- 18 installed in the vehicle and the weight of a comparable diesel
- 19 fuel tank and fueling system.
- 20 b. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
- 21 a motor vehicle described in paragraph "a" equipped with an
- 22 auxiliary power or idle reduction technology unit that reduces
- 23 fuel use and emissions during engine idling may exceed any
- 24 applicable maximum gross weight limit under this chapter by
- 25 five hundred fifty pounds or the weight of the auxiliary power
- 26 or idle reduction technology unit, whichever is less. This
- 27 paragraph "b" shall not apply unless the operator of the vehicle
- 28 provides to the department a written certification of the
- 29 weight of the auxiliary power or idle reduction technology
- 30 unit, demonstrates or certifies to the department that the idle
- 31 reduction technology unit is fully functional at all times,
- 32 and carries with the operator the written certification of the
- 33 weight of the auxiliary power or idle reduction technology unit
- 34 in the vehicle at all times to present to law enforcement in
- 35 the event the vehicle is suspected of violating any applicable

- 2 Sec. 3. Section 321.477, Code 2017, is amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 321.477 Employees as peace officers maximum age.
- 5 l. The department may designate by resolution certain of
- 6 its employees upon each of whom there is hereby conferred the
- 7 authority of a peace officer to enforce the laws of this state
- 8 described in subsection 2. Employees designated as peace
- 9 officers pursuant to this section shall have the same powers
- 10 conferred by law on peace officers for the enforcement of such
- 11 laws and the apprehension of violators.
- 12 2. Employees designated as peace officers pursuant to
- 13 this section shall only engage in the following enforcement
- 14 activities:
- 15 a. The enforcement of federal motor carrier safety
- 16 regulations and federal motor carrier hazardous materials
- 17 regulations as adopted in this chapter and in rules adopted by
- 18 the department under this chapter.
- 19 b. The regulation of the operating authority of motor
- 20 carriers.
- 21 c. The regulation of the movement, safety, and lawful
- 22 operation of commercial motor vehicles.
- 23 d. The regulation of the operating authority of commercial
- 24 motor vehicle operators and the enforcement of traffic and
- 25 safety laws on operators of commercial motor vehicles.
- 26 e. The enforcement and performance of other activities
- 27 necessary for the motor carrier safety assistance program and
- 28 the high priority program administered under 49 C.F.R. pt.
- 29 350.
- 30 f. The investigation and enforcement of matters relating to
- 31 or arising out of responsibilities entrusted to the department.
- 32 g. The control and direct direction of traffic and weigh
- 33 vehicles, and to make arrests for violations of the.
- 34 h. The enforcement of motor vehicle laws relating to
- 35 the operating authority, registration, size, weight, and

- 1 load of motor vehicles and trailers and registration of a
- 2 motor carrier's interstate transportation service with the
- 3 department.
- 4 i. The enforcement of laws, the violation of which are
- 5 defined as serious violations under 761 IAC 615.17(2).
- j. The enforcement of speed restrictions where a motor
- 7 vehicle is traveling twenty miles per hour or more over the
- 8 legal speed limit.
- 9 k. The enforcement of rules and regulations of the
- 10 department.
- 11 3. The maximum age for a person employed as a peace officer
- 12 pursuant to this section is sixty-five years of age.
- 13 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT. The section of this Act
- 14 amending section 321.477, being deemed of immediate importance,
- 15 takes effect upon enactment.
