- 1 Section 1. Section 724.4, subsection 4, Code 2018, is
- 2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 3 NEW PARAGRAPH. 1. A person who is eighteen years of age
- 4 or older who goes armed with a dangerous weapon that directs
- 5 an electric current, impulse, wave, or beam that produces a
- 6 high-voltage pulse designed to immobilize a person, as long
- 7 as such a dangerous weapon does not generate a projectile
- 8 that directs an electric current, impulse, wave, or beam that
- 9 produces a high-voltage pulse designed to immobilize a person,
- 10 and such a dangerous weapon is not used in the commission of a
- 11 public offense.
- 12 Sec. 2. Section 724.4, Code 2018, is amended by adding the
- 13 following new subsection:
- 14 NEW SUBSECTION. 5. A minor who goes armed with a dangerous
- 15 weapon that directs an electric current, impulse, wave, or beam
- 16 that produces a high-voltage pulse designed to immobilize a
- 17 person, whether concealed or not, commits a simple misdemeanor.
