A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for the sale of certain mushrooms at farmers
2 markets, and providing an effective date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 137F.2, Code 2019, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 **137F.2 Adoption by rule.**

4 1. The department shall, in accordance with **chapter 17A**,
5 adopt rules setting minimum standards for entities covered
6 under **this chapter** to protect consumers from foodborne
7 illness. In so doing, the department may adopt by reference,
8 with or without amendment, the United States food and drug
9 administration food code, which shall be specified by title
10 and edition, date of publication, or similar information. The
11 rules and standards shall be formulated in consultation with
12 municipal corporations under agreement with the department,
13 affected state agencies, and industry, professional, and
14 consumer groups.

15 2. In establishing minimum standards as described in
16 subsection 1, the department shall adopt rules for the sale at
17 a farmers market of culinary mushrooms commonly referred to as
18 a variety of wild golden oyster and classified as pleurotus
19 ostreatus, pleurotus populinus, or pleurotus pulmonarius.

20 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
21 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
