## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to public school funding by establishing the
- 2 state percent of growth and the categorical state percent of
- 3 growth for the budget year beginning July 1, 2022, modifying
- 4 provisions relating to the regular program state cost per
- 5 pupil, modifying provisions relating to the property tax
- 6 replacement payment and the transportation equity payments,
- 7 and including effective date provisions.
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 257.8, subsections 1 and 2, Code 2022, 2 are amended to read as follows:
- 3 1. State percent of growth. The state percent of growth
- 4 for the budget year beginning July 1, 2019, is two and six
- 5 hundredths percent. The state percent of growth for the budget
- 6 year beginning July 1, 2020, is two and three-tenths percent.
- 7 The state percent of growth for the budget year beginning July
- 8 1, 2021, is two and four-tenths percent. The state percent
- 9 of growth for the budget year beginning July 1, 2022, is two
- 10 and one-half percent. The state percent of growth for each
- 11 subsequent budget year shall be established by statute which
- 12 shall be enacted within thirty days of the transmission of the
- 13 governor's budget required by February 1 under section 8.21
- 14 during the regular legislative session beginning in the base 15 year.
- 2. Categorical state percent of growth. The categorical
- 17 state percent of growth for the budget year beginning July
- 18 1, 2019, is two and six hundredths percent. The categorical
- 19 state percent of growth for the budget year beginning July
- 20 1, 2020, is two and three-tenths percent. The categorical
- 21 state percent of growth for the budget year beginning July 1,
- 22 2021, is two and four-tenths percent. The categorical state
- 23 percent of growth for the budget year beginning July 1, 2022,
- 24 is two and one-half percent. The categorical state percent of
- 25 growth for each budget year shall be established by statute
- 26 which shall be enacted within thirty days of the transmission
- 27 of the governor's budget required by February 1 under section
- 28 8.21 during the regular legislative session beginning in the
- 29 base year. The categorical state percent of growth may include
- 30 state percents of growth for the teacher salary supplement, the
- 31 professional development supplement, the early intervention
- 32 supplement, the teacher leadership supplement, and for budget
- 33 years beginning on or after July 1, 2020, transportation equity
- 34 aid payments under section 257.16C.
- 35 Sec. 2. Section 257.9, subsection 2, Code 2022, is amended

1 to read as follows:

- 2 2. Regular program state cost per pupil for 1992-1993 and 3 succeeding years.
- 4 a. For the budget year beginning July 1, 1992, and
- 5 succeeding budget years beginning before July 1, 2018, the
- 6 regular program state cost per pupil for a budget year is the
- 7 regular program state cost per pupil for the base year plus the
- 8 regular program supplemental state aid for the budget year.
- 9 b. For the budget year beginning July 1, 2018, the regular
- 10 program state cost per pupil is the regular program state
- ll cost per pupil for the base year plus the regular program
- 12 supplemental state aid for the budget year, plus five dollars.
- 13 c. For the budget year beginning July 1, 2019, the regular
- 14 program state cost per pupil is the regular program state
- 15 cost per pupil for the base year plus the regular program
- 16 supplemental state aid for the budget year, plus five dollars.
- d. For the budget year beginning July 1, 2020, the regular
- 18 program state cost per pupil is the regular program state
- 19 cost per pupil for the base year plus the regular program
- 20 supplemental state aid for the budget year, plus ten dollars.
- 21 e. For the budget year beginning July 1, 2021, the regular
- 22 program state cost per pupil is the regular program state
- 23 cost per pupil for the base year plus the regular program
- 24 supplemental state aid for the budget year, plus ten dollars.
- 25 f. For the budget year beginning July 1, 2022, the regular
- 26 program state cost per pupil is the regular program state
- 27 cost per pupil for the base year plus the regular program
- 28 supplemental state aid for the budget year, plus five dollars.
- 29 f, g. For the budget year beginning July 1,  $\frac{2022}{2023}$ , and
- 30 succeeding budget years, the regular program state cost per
- 31 pupil for a budget year is the regular program state cost per
- 32 pupil for the base year plus the regular program supplemental
- 33 state aid for the budget year.
- 34 Sec. 3. Section 257.16B, subsections 1 and 2, Code 2022, are
- 35 amended to read as follows:

- 1 l. For each fiscal year beginning on or after July 1,  $\frac{2019}{}$
- 2 2020, there is appropriated from the general fund of the state
- 3 to the department of education an amount necessary to make all
- 4 school district property tax replacement payments under this
- 5 section, as calculated in subsection 2.
- 6 2. a. For the budget year beginning July 1, 2019, the
- 7 department of management shall calculate for each school
- 8 district all of the following:
- 9 (1) The regular program state cost per pupil for the budget
- 10 year beginning July 1, 2012, multiplied by one hundred percent
- 11 less the regular program foundation base per pupil percentage
- 12 pursuant to section 257.1.
- 13 (2) The regular program state cost per pupil for the budget
- 14 year beginning July 1, 2019, multiplied by one hundred percent
- 15 less the regular program foundation base per pupil percentage
- 16 pursuant to section 257.1.
- 17 (3) The amount of each school district's property tax
- 18 replacement payment. Each school district's property tax
- 19 replacement payment equals the school district's weighted
- 20 enrollment for the budget year beginning July 1, 2019,
- 21 multiplied by the remainder of the amount calculated for
- 22 the school district under subparagraph (2) minus the amount
- 23 calculated for the school district under subparagraph (1).
- 24 b. a. For the budget year beginning July 1, 2020, the
- 25 department of management shall calculate for each school
- 26 district all of the following:
- 27 (1) The regular program state cost per pupil for the budget
- 28 year beginning July 1, 2012, multiplied by one hundred percent
- 29 less the regular program foundation base per pupil percentage
- 30 pursuant to section 257.1 for the budget year beginning July
- 31 1, 2020.
- 32 (2) The regular program state cost per pupil for the budget
- 33 year beginning July 1, 2020, multiplied by one hundred percent
- 34 less the regular program foundation base per pupil percentage
- 35 pursuant to section 257.1 for the budget year beginning July

- 1 1, 2020.
- 2 (3) The amount of each school district's property tax
- 3 replacement payment. Each school district's property tax
- 4 replacement payment equals the school district's weighted
- 5 enrollment for the budget year beginning July 1, 2020,
- 6 multiplied by the remainder of the amount calculated for
- 7 the school district under subparagraph (2) minus the amount
- 8 calculated for the school district under subparagraph (1).
- 9 c. b. For each the budget year beginning on or after July
- 10 1, 2021, the department of management shall calculate for each
- ll school district all of the following:
- 12 (1) The regular program state cost per pupil for the budget
- 13 year beginning July 1, 2012, multiplied by one hundred percent
- 14 less the regular program foundation base per pupil percentage
- 15 pursuant to section 257.1 for the budget year beginning July

- 23 replacement payment. Each school district's property tax

- 27 the school district under subparagraph (2) minus the amount
- 28 calculated for the school district under subparagraph (1).
- 29 c. (1) For each budget year beginning on or after July
- 30 1, 2022, the amount of each school district's property
- 31 tax replacement payment shall be the product of the school
- 32 district's weighted enrollment for the budget year multiplied
- 33 by the per pupil property tax replacement amount for the budget
- 34 year calculated under subparagraph (2).
- 35 (2) The per pupil property tax replacement amount for budget

- 1 years beginning on or after July 1, 2022, is equal to the sum
- 2 of one hundred fifty-three dollars plus the difference between
- 3 the following:
- 4 (a) The regular program state cost per pupil for the budget
- 5 year beginning July 1, 2022, multiplied by one hundred percent
- 6 less the regular program foundation base per pupil percentage
- 7 pursuant to section 257.1 for the applicable budget year under
- 8 this paragraph.
- 9 (b) The regular program state cost per pupil for the budget
- 10 year beginning July 1, 2021, multiplied by one hundred percent
- 11 less the regular program foundation base per pupil percentage
- 12 pursuant to section 257.1 for the applicable budget year under
- 13 this paragraph.
- 14 Sec. 4. Section 257.16C, subsection 3, paragraph d,
- 15 subparagraphs (3) and (4), Code 2022, are amended to read as
- 16 follows:
- 17 (3) For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and the
- 18 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, there is appropriated from
- 19 the general fund of the state to the department of management
- 20 for deposit in the transportation equity fund an amount
- 21 necessary to make all transportation equity aid payments under
- 22 subsection 2, to be used for the purposes of this section.
- 23 (4) For each fiscal year beginning on or after July 1,
- 24 <del>2022</del> 2023, there is appropriated from the general fund of
- 25 the state to the department of management for deposit in the
- 26 transportation equity fund the sum of the following, or so much
- 27 thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes of this
- 28 section:
- 29 (a) The amount appropriated to the transportation equity
- 30 fund under this subparagraph paragraph for the immediately
- 31 preceding fiscal year.
- (b) The product of the amount determined under subparagraph
- 33 division (a) multiplied by the categorical percent of growth
- 34 under section 257.8, subsection 2, for the budget year
- 35 beginning on the same date of the fiscal year for which the

- 1 appropriation is made.
- 2 Sec. 5. CODE SECTION 257.8 IMPLEMENTATION. The
- 3 requirements of section 257.8, subsections 1 and 2, regarding
- 4 the enactment of bills establishing the state percent of growth
- 5 and the categorical state percent of growth within thirty
- 6 days of the transmission of the governor's budget required by
- 7 February 1 under section 8.21 during the regular legislative
- 8 session beginning in the base year, do not apply to this Act.
- 9 Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 10 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
