A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning benefits relating to members of the public
- 2 safety peace officers' retirement, accident, and disability
- 3 system, and the municipal fire and police retirement system.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 97A.1, subsection 6, Code 2024, is
- 2 amended by striking the subsection and inserting in lieu
- 3 thereof the following:
- 4 6. "Cancer" means a group of diseases involving abnormal
- 5 cell growth with the potential to invade or spread to other
- 6 parts of the body.
- 7 Sec. 2. Section 411.1, subsection 6, Code 2024, is amended
- 8 by striking the subsection and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 9 following:
- 10 6. "Cancer" means a group of diseases involving abnormal
- 11 cell growth with the potential to invade or spread to other
- 12 parts of the body.
- 13 Sec. 3. Section 411.1, Code 2024, is amended by adding the
- 14 following new subsection:
- 15 NEW SUBSECTION. 8A. "Cost-sharing" means any coverage
- 16 limit, copayment, coinsurance, deductible, or other
- 17 out-of-pocket cost obligation related to an injury or disease
- 18 incurred while in the performance of duties.
- 19 Sec. 4. Section 411.15, Code 2024, is amended to read as
- 20 follows:
- 21 411.15 Hospitalization and medical attention.
- 22 l. Cities shall provide hospital, nursing, and physical
- 23 or mental medical attention for the members of the police and
- 24 fire departments of the cities, when injured while in the
- 25 performance of their duties as members of such department, and
- 26 shall continue to provide hospital, nursing, and physical or
- 27 mental medical attention for injuries or diseases incurred
- 28 while in the performance of their duties for members receiving
- 29 a retirement allowance under section 411.6, subsection 6.
- 30 2. Cities may fund the cost of the hospital, nursing, and
- 31 physical or mental medical attention required by this section
- 32 through the purchase of insurance, including by processing
- 33 claims concerning the cancer, heart, and lung or respiratory
- 34 issues described in section 411.6, subsection 5, paragraph c,
- 35 through their group health insurance plan as long as the member

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1 is not responsible for any cost-sharing; by self-insuring 2 the obligation; or through payment of moneys into a local 3 government risk pool established for the purpose of covering 4 the costs associated with the requirements of this section. 5 However, the cost of the hospital, nursing, and physical or 6 mental medical attention required by this section shall not 7 be funded through an employee-paid health insurance policy, 8 except as otherwise specified in this subsection . 9 heart disease, and lung or respiratory diseases described in 10 section 411.6, subsection 5, paragraph "c", shall not be deemed 11 work-related for purposes of coverage through the employer's 12 group health insurance plan. The cost of the hospital, nursing, and physical or mental 13 14 medical attention required by this section shall be paid from 15 moneys held in a trust and agency fund established pursuant to 16 section 384.6, or out of the appropriation for the department 17 to which the injured person belongs or belonged+, provided 18 that any amounts received by the injured person from any other 19 source for such specific purposes, shall be deducted from the 20 amount paid by the city under the provisions of this section. 21 IMPLEMENTATION OF ACT. Section 25B.2, subsection Sec. 5. 22 3, shall not apply to this Act.
