A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to teacher and education support professional
- 2 compensation, including teacher salary supplement cost
- 3 per pupil calculations, teacher minimum starting salary
- 4 requirements, Iowa public employees' retirement system bona
- 5 fide retirement requirements, and school district budget
- 6 statement reporting, making appropriations, and including
- 7 effective date provisions.
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- Section 1. Section 97B.52A, subsection 1, paragraph c, 2 subparagraph (2), Code 2024, is amended by adding the following 3 new subparagraph division:

 MEW SUBPARAGRAPH DIVISION. (d) For a member whose first 5 month of entitlement is July 2024 or later, but before July 6 2027, the member may return to covered employment as a teacher 7 for a covered employer after receiving one month of retirement 8 benefits. For the purposes of this subparagraph division, 9 "teacher" means a teacher licensed under chapter 256.

 Sec. 2. Section 257.10, subsection 9, paragraphs a and d, 11 Code 2024, are amended to read as follows:

 a. (1) For the budget year beginning July 1, 2009, the 13 department of management shall add together the teacher 14 compensation allocation made to each district for the fiscal
- compensation allocation made to each district for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008, pursuant to section 284.13, 16 subsection 1, paragraph "h", Code 2009, and the phase II 17 allocation made to each district for the fiscal year beginning 18 July 1, 2008, pursuant to section 294A.9, Code 2009, and divide 19 that sum by the district's budget enrollment in the fiscal 20 year beginning July 1, 2009, to determine the teacher salary 21 supplement district cost per pupil. For the budget year 22 beginning July 1, 2010, and succeeding budget years beginning 23 before July 1, 2024, the teacher salary supplement district 24 cost per pupil for each school district for a budget year 25 is the teacher salary supplement program district cost per 26 pupil for the base year plus the teacher salary supplement 27 supplemental state aid amount for the budget year.
- (2) (a) For the budget year beginning July 1, 2024, the department of management shall calculate for each school district a teacher salary supplement district cost per pupil amount based on the sum of the following:
- (i) An amount necessary to allow the school district to provide a minimum teacher starting salary of forty-seven thousand five hundred dollars in accordance with the requirements of chapter 284, including costs associated with

- 1 the employer's share of contributions to the Iowa public
- 2 employees' retirement system and the employer's share of the
- 3 tax imposed by the federal Insurance Contributions Act.
- 4 (ii) An amount necessary to allow the school district
- 5 to provide an hourly wage of fifteen dollars per hour for
- 6 education support personnel, including costs associated with
- 7 the employer's share of contributions to the Iowa public
- 8 employees' retirement system and the employer's share of
- 9 the tax imposed by the federal Insurance Contributions Act.
- 10 However, if the amount calculated under this subparagraph
- 11 subdivision for all school districts exceeds fourteen million
- 12 dollars, the department of management shall proportionally
- 13 reduce the amount calculated for school districts, based on the
- 14 original calculation, so that the total amount calculated for
- 15 all school districts is fourteen million dollars.
- 16 (iii) To supplement teacher salaries and the wages of
- 17 education support personnel in a manner that promotes quality
- 18 teaching and rewards experience, twenty-two million dollars
- 19 multiplied by the quotient of the school district's budget
- 20 enrollment for the budget year beginning July 1, 2023, and
- 21 ending June 30, 2024, divided by the statewide total budget
- 22 enrollment for the budget year beginning July 1, 2023, and
- 23 ending June 30, 2024.
- 24 (b) For the budget year beginning July 1, 2025, the
- 25 department of management shall calculate for each school
- 26 district a teacher salary supplement district cost per pupil
- 27 amount based on the sum of the following:
- 28 (i) An amount necessary to allow the school district to
- 29 provide a minimum teacher starting salary of fifty thousand
- 30 dollars in accordance with the requirements of chapter 284,
- 31 including costs associated with the employer's share of
- 32 contributions to the Iowa public employees' retirement system
- 33 and the employer's share of the tax imposed by the federal
- 34 Insurance Contributions Act.
- 35 (ii) To allow each school district to provide an hourly wage

- 1 of fifteen dollars per hour to education support personnel, the
- 2 amount calculated for the base year under subparagraph division
- 3 (a), subparagraph subdivision (ii), after the reduction if
- 4 applicable, plus the product of that same amount multiplied
- 5 by the categorical percent of growth under section 257.8,
- 6 subsection 2, for the budget year.
- 7 (iii) To supplement teacher salaries and the wages of
- 8 education support personnel in a manner that promotes quality
- 9 teaching and rewards experience, the amount calculated for
- 10 the base year under subparagraph division (a), subparagraph
- 11 subdivision (iii), plus the product of that same amount
- 12 multiplied by the categorical percent of growth under section
- 13 257.8, subsection 2, for the budget year.
- 14 (c) For the budget year beginning July 1, 2026, and
- 15 succeeding budget years, the teacher salary supplement district
- 16 cost per pupil for each school district for a budget year is
- 17 equal to the sum of the following:
- 18 (i) To allow the school district to provide minimum teacher
- 19 starting salaries in accordance with the requirements of
- 20 chapter 284, for the budget year beginning July 1, 2026, the
- 21 amount calculated for the base year under subparagraph division
- 22 (b), subparagraph subdivision (i), plus the product of that
- 23 same amount multiplied by the categorical percent of growth
- 24 under section 257.8, subsection 2, for the budget year. For
- 25 the budget year beginning July 1, 2027, and succeeding budget
- 26 years, the amount calculated for the base year under this
- 27 subparagraph subdivision, plus the product of that same amount
- 28 multiplied by the categorical percent of growth under section
- 29 257.8, subsection 2, for the budget year.
- 30 (ii) To allow each school district to provide an hourly wage
- 31 of fifteen dollars per hour to education support personnel, for
- 32 the budget year beginning July 1, 2026, the amount calculated
- 33 for the base year under subparagraph division (b), subparagraph
- 34 subdivision (ii), plus the product of that same amount
- 35 multiplied by the categorical percent of growth under section

- 1 257.8, subsection 2, for the budget year. For the budget
- 2 year beginning July 1, 2027, and succeeding budget years, the
- 3 amount calculated for the base year under this subparagraph
- 4 subdivision, plus the product of that same amount multiplied
- 5 by the categorical percent of growth under section 257.8,
- 6 subsection 2, for the budget year.
- 7 (iii) To supplement teacher salaries and the wages of
- 8 education support personnel in a manner that promotes quality
- 9 teaching and rewards experience, for the budget year beginning
- 10 July 1, 2026, the amount calculated for the base year under
- 11 subparagraph division (b), subparagraph subdivision (iii), plus
- 12 the product of that same amount multiplied by the categorical
- 13 percent of growth under section 257.8, subsection 2, for the
- 14 budget year. For the budget year beginning July 1, 2027, and
- 15 succeeding budget years, the amount calculated for the base
- 16 year under this subparagraph subdivision, plus the product
- 17 of that same amount multiplied by the categorical percent of
- 18 growth under section 257.8, subsection 2, for the budget year.
- 19 d. For the budget year beginning July 1, 2010, and
- 20 succeeding budget years, the use of the funds calculated
- 21 under this subsection or available for use as provided in
- 22 subsection 10, paragraph "d", subsection 12, paragraph "d", or
- 23 section 257.46, subsection 3, shall be distributed to teachers
- 24 pursuant to section 284.3A and shall comply in compliance with
- 25 the requirements of chapter 284 related to such distribution
- 26 under section 284.3A and shall be distributed to teachers and
- 27 education support personnel as described in paragraph "a".
- 28 Sec. 3. Section 257.10, subsection 9, Code 2024, is amended
- 29 by adding the following new paragraph:
- 30 NEW PARAGRAPH. e. For purposes of this subsection,
- 31 "education support personnel" means regular and part-time
- 32 employees of a school district who are not salaried.
- 33 Sec. 4. Section 257.10, subsection 12, paragraph d, Code
- 34 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 35 d. Except as otherwise allowed under this paragraph, for

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1 the budget year beginning July 1, 2014, and succeeding budget
 2 years, the use of the funds calculated under this subsection
 3 shall comply with the requirements of chapter 284 and shall
 4 be distributed to teachers pursuant to section 284.15.
 5 funds shall be used only to increase the payment for a teacher
 6 assigned to a leadership role pursuant to a framework or
 7 comparable system approved pursuant to section 284.15; to
 8 increase the percentages of teachers assigned to leadership
 9 roles; to increase the minimum teacher starting salary to
10 thirty-three thousand five hundred dollars the amount described
11 in section 284.15, subsection 2, paragraph "a", subparagraph
12 (1); to cover the costs for the time mentor and lead teachers
13 are not providing instruction to students in a classroom;
14 for coverage of a classroom when an initial or career
15 teacher is observing or co-teaching with a teacher assigned
16 to a leadership role; for professional development time to
17 learn best practices associated with the career pathways
18 leadership process; and for other costs associated with a
19 framework or comparable system approved by the department of
20 education under section 284.15 with the goals of improving
21 instruction and elevating the quality of teaching and student
22 learning. If all requirements for the school district for
23 the use of funds calculated under this subsection are met
24 and funds received under this subsection remain unexpended
25 and unobligated at the end of a fiscal year beginning on or
26 after July 1, 2020, the school district may transfer all or a
27 portion of such unexpended and unobligated funds for deposit
28 in the school district's flexibility account established
29 under section 298A.2, subsection 2. At the end of a fiscal
30 year beginning on or after July 1, 2022, school districts may
31 use all or a portion of funds under this subsection for the
32 purposes authorized under subsection 9, paragraph "d", and,
33 notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, school
34 districts shall not be required to participate in or comply
35 with section 284.15 in order to continue to receive funding
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- 1 under this subsection.
- 2 Sec. 5. Section 284.15, subsection 2, paragraph a,
- 3 subparagraph (1), Code 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) (a) The For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, the
- 5 salary for an initial teacher who has successfully completed an
- 6 approved practitioner preparation program as defined in section
- 7 256.145 or holds an initial or intern teacher license issued
- 8 under chapter 256, subchapter VII, part 3, shall be at least
- 9 thirty-three forty-seven thousand five hundred dollars, which
- 10 shall also constitute the minimum salary for an Iowa teacher.
- ll (b) For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and each
- 12 subsequent fiscal year, the salary for an initial teacher who
- 13 has successfully completed an approved practitioner preparation
- 14 program as defined in section 256.145 or holds an initial or
- 15 intern teacher license issued under chapter 256, subchapter
- 16 VII, part 3, shall be at least fifty thousand dollars, which
- 17 shall also constitute the minimum salary for an Iowa teacher.
- 18 Sec. 6. Section 284.16, subsection 1, paragraph a,
- 19 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2024, is amended to read as
- 20 follows:
- 21 The For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, the beginning
- 22 teacher shall be paid not less than thirty-three forty-seven
- 23 thousand five hundred dollars and. For the fiscal year
- 24 beginning July 1, 2025, and each subsequent fiscal year, the
- 25 beginning teacher shall be paid not less than fifty thousand
- 26 dollars. Each beginning teacher shall meet the following
- 27 requirements:
- 28 Sec. 7. Section 284.17, subsection 1, Code 2024, is amended
- 29 to read as follows:
- 30 1. a. A For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, the
- 31 minimum salary of thirty-three forty-seven thousand five
- 32 hundred dollars for a full-time teacher.
- 33 b. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and each
- 34 subsequent fiscal year, the minimum salary of fifty thousand
- 35 dollars for a full-time teacher.

- 1 Sec. 8. SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET STATEMENTS FISCAL YEAR 2 BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024.
- Notwithstanding section 24.2A, subsection 2, paragraph
- 4 "a", each school district shall file with the department of
- 5 management a report containing all necessary information for
- 6 the department of management to compile and calculate amounts
- 7 required to be included in the statements for the budget year
- 8 beginning July 1, 2024, mailed under section 24.2A, subsection
- 9 2, paragraph "b", no later than thirty calendar days after the
- 10 effective date of 2024 Iowa Acts, House File 2613, or successor
- 11 legislation, if enacted.
- 12 2. Notwithstanding section 24.2A, subsection 2, paragraph
- 13 "b", each county auditor, using information received under
- 14 subsection 1, shall send to each property owner or taxpayer
- 15 within the county by regular mail an individual statement
- 16 containing all of the information required by section
- 17 24.2A, subsection 2, paragraph "b", for each school district
- 18 comprising the owner's or taxpayer's taxing district no later
- 19 than thirty-five calendar days after the effective date of
- 20 2024 Iowa Acts, House File 2613, or successor legislation, if
- 21 enacted.
- 22 Sec. 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 23 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
