A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to school districts, including authorizing
- 2 the parent or guardian of a student enrolled in a school
- 3 district to enroll the student in another attendance
- 4 center within the same school district in certain specified
- 5 circumstances, requiring school district employees to
- 6 provide notice to the parents or guardians of students
- 7 enrolled in the school district if the employee witnesses
- 8 the student being physically injured, harassed, or bullied,
- 9 and including effective date provisions.
- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 279.77 Intra-district enrollment.
- A parent or quardian of a student enrolled in a
- 3 school district may enroll the student in another attendance
- 4 center within the same school district that offers classes
- 5 at the student's grade level in the manner provided in this
- 6 section if, as a result of viewing a recording created by a
- 7 video surveillance system or a report from a school district
- 8 employee, the board of directors of the school district
- 9 determines that any student enrolled in the school district
- 10 has harassed or bullied the student. For purposes of this
- 11 subsection, "harassment" and "bullying" mean the same as defined
- 12 in section 280.28.
- 2. a. A parent or guardian shall send notification to the
- 14 board of directors of the school district, on forms prescribed
- 15 by the department of education, that the parent or guardian
- 16 intends to enroll the student in another attendance center
- 17 within the same school district that offers classes at the
- 18 student's grade level.
- 19 b. The board of directors of the school district shall
- 20 enroll the student in another attendance center within the same
- 21 school district unless the attendance center has insufficient
- 22 classroom space for the student. The board of directors of a
- 23 school district may adopt a policy granting the superintendent
- 24 of the school district authority to approve requests submitted
- 25 pursuant to this section. If the request is granted, the board
- 26 of directors of the school district shall transmit a copy of
- 27 the form to the parent or quardian within five days after board
- 28 action. The parent or guardian may withdraw the request at any
- 29 time prior to the board of directors' action on the request.
- 30 A denial of a request by the board of directors is not subject
- 31 to appeal.
- 32 c. Each school district shall adopt a policy that defines
- 33 the term "insufficient classroom space" for that district.
- 34 3. A request under this section is for a period of not
- 35 less than one year. A student who attends school in another

- 1 attendance center pursuant to this section may return to the
- 2 original attendance center and enroll at any time, once the
- 3 parent or guardian has notified the board of directors of
- 4 the school district in writing of the decision to enroll the
- 5 student in the original attendance center.
- 6 4. If a request filed under this section is for a student
- 7 requiring special education under chapter 256B, the request to
- 8 transfer to another attendance center shall only be granted if
- 9 all of the following conditions are met:
- 10 a. The attendance center maintains a special education
- 11 instructional program that is appropriate to meet the student's
- 12 educational needs and the enrollment of the student in the
- 13 attendance center would not cause the size of the class or
- 14 caseload in that special education instructional program in the
- 15 attendance center to exceed the maximum class size or caseload
- 16 established pursuant to rules adopted by the state board of
- 17 education.
- 18 b. If the student would be assigned to a general education
- 19 class, there is sufficient classroom space for the general
- 20 education class to which the student would be assigned.
- 21 5. If a student, for whom a request to transfer has been
- 22 filed with the board of directors of a school district, has
- 23 been suspended or expelled in the school district, the student
- 24 shall not be permitted to transfer until the student has been
- 25 reinstated. Once the student has been reinstated, however, the
- 26 student shall be permitted to transfer in the same manner as if
- 27 the student had not been suspended or expelled. If a student,
- 28 for whom a request to transfer has been filed with the board
- 29 of directors of a school district, is expelled in the school
- 30 district, the student shall be permitted to transfer under this
- 31 section if the student applies for and is reinstated. However,
- 32 if the student applies for reinstatement but is not reinstated
- 33 in the school district, the board of directors of the school
- 34 district may deny the request to transfer. The decision of
- 35 the board of directors of the school district is not subject

- 1 to appeal.
- A student who is enrolled in another attendance center
- 3 within the same school district pursuant to this section is
- 4 eligible to participate immediately in varsity interscholastic
- 5 athletic contests and athletic competitions as a member of a
- 6 team from the receiving attendance center.
- 7. This section shall not be construed to prohibit a
- 8 school district from allowing the parent or guardian of a
- 9 student enrolled in the school district to enroll the student
- 10 in another attendance center within the same school district
- 11 that offers classes at the student's grade level pursuant to a
- 12 policy adopted by the board of directors of the school district
- 13 that allows for transfers for reasons in addition to those
- 14 allowed pursuant to this section.
- 15 8. The state board of education shall adopt rules pursuant
- 16 to chapter 17A to administer this section.
- 17 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 279.78 Notice to parents or guardians
- 18 related to physical injuries, harassment, or bullying.
- 19 An employee of a school district shall notify the parents
- 20 or guardians of a student enrolled in the school district in
- 21 writing or by electronic mail within twenty-four hours after
- 22 the employee witnesses, either directly or indirectly by
- 23 viewing a recording created by a video surveillance system, any
- 24 of the following:
- 25 l. Any student enrolled in the school district physically
- 26 injuring the student.
- 27 2. Any student enrolled in the school district harassing
- 28 or bullying the student. For purposes of this subsection,
- 29 "harassment" and "bullying" mean the same as defined in section
- 30 280.28.
- 31 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 32 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
