A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the ordering and administering of
2 epinephrine auto-injectors and self-administered hormonal
3 contraceptives to persons ages eighteen years and older by a
4 pharmacist pursuant to statewide protocols.
5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 155A.46, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
2 2023, is amended to read as follows:

3 a. A pharmacist may, pursuant to statewide protocols
4 developed by the board in consultation with the department of
5 public health and human services and consistent with subsection
6 2, order and administer the following to patients ages eighteen
7 years and older:

8 (1) Naloxone.

9 (2) Nicotine replacement tobacco cessation products.

10 (3) An immunization or vaccination recommended by the
11 United States centers for disease control and prevention
12 advisory committee on immunization practices in its approved
13 vaccination schedule for adults.

14 (4) An immunization or vaccination recommended by the
15 United States centers for disease control and prevention for
16 international travel.

17 (5) A Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis)
18 vaccination in a booster application.

19 (6) Other emergency immunizations or vaccinations in
20 response to a public health emergency.

21 (7) An immunization or vaccination for COVID-19 as defined
22 in [section 686D.2](#).

23 (8) Epinephrine auto-injectors.

24 (9) Self-administered hormonal contraceptives. For
25 the purposes of this subparagraph, "self-administered
26 hormonal contraceptive" means a self-administered hormonal
27 contraceptive that is approved by the United States food and
28 drug administration to prevent pregnancy. "Self-administered
29 hormonal contraceptive" includes an oral hormonal contraceptive,
30 a hormonal vaginal ring, and a hormonal contraceptive patch,
31 but does not include any drug intended to induce an abortion as
32 defined in section 146.1.
