A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the regulation of tanning facilities, and
- 2 making penalties applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. **136D.5 Minors' use of tanning**
2 **devices — restrictions.**

3 1. A tanning facility shall not allow a person under eighteen
4 years of age to use a tanning device unless the parent or
5 guardian of the person first provides written consent in person
6 to the tanning facility for the person to use a tanning device,
7 which must include the following statement:

8 UV tanning devices increase the risk of melanoma, a particularly
9 deadly type of skin cancer. UV radiation is most dangerous when
10 exposed at a young age.

11 2. A written consent provided pursuant to subsection 1 shall
12 remain valid for subsequent visits to the tanning facility.
13 However, the written consent may be revoked at any time by the
14 parent or guardian who provided it.
