A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the enforcement of immigration laws, and
2 providing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. **27A.12 Failure to comply.**

2 1. Any law enforcement officer, including an elected sheriff,
3 who knowingly and intentionally fails to comply with the
4 requirements of this chapter shall be subject to investigation by
5 the attorney general as provided in section 27A.8.

6 2. A law enforcement officer subject to investigation under
7 subsection 1 shall be given the opportunity to comply with
8 the requirements of this chapter. Upon a determination by
9 the attorney general that a complaint submitted pursuant to
10 subsection 1 alleging a violation of this section is valid, a law
11 enforcement officer refusing to comply with the requirements of
12 this chapter may have the officer's case referred to the Iowa law
13 enforcement academy council, pursuant to section 80B.13A, with a
14 recommendation for revocation of the officer's certification.
