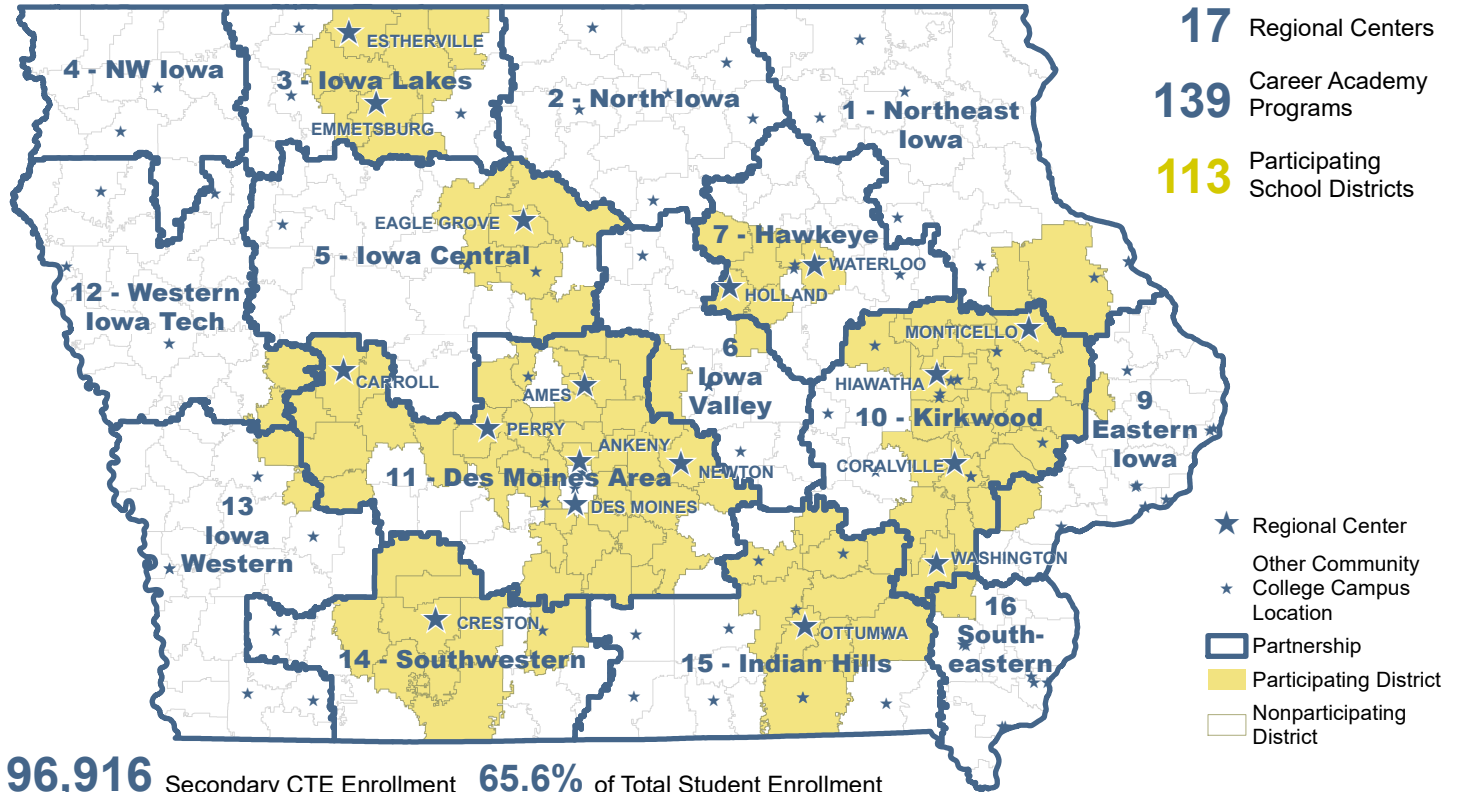


# Career and Technical Education (CTE) — 2018

[House File 2392](#) established a system for aligning a policy framework for secondary CTE with the [Perkins V State Plan](#). Part of this includes the establishment of Regional Planning Partnerships (RPPs), which may also designate a regional center where multiple CTE programs are accessed. Regional centers are required to include at least four career academy programs and must include either: two school districts with a combined total of 120 participating students; or a total of four school districts, with no minimum enrollment expectation.

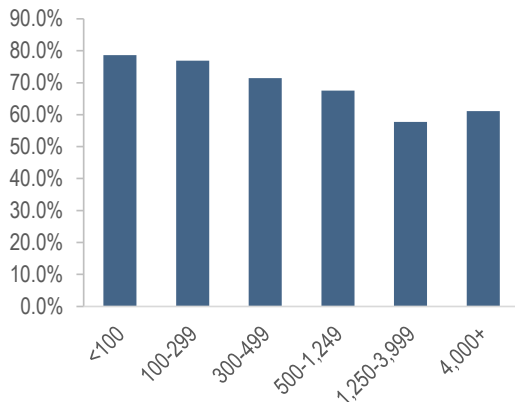

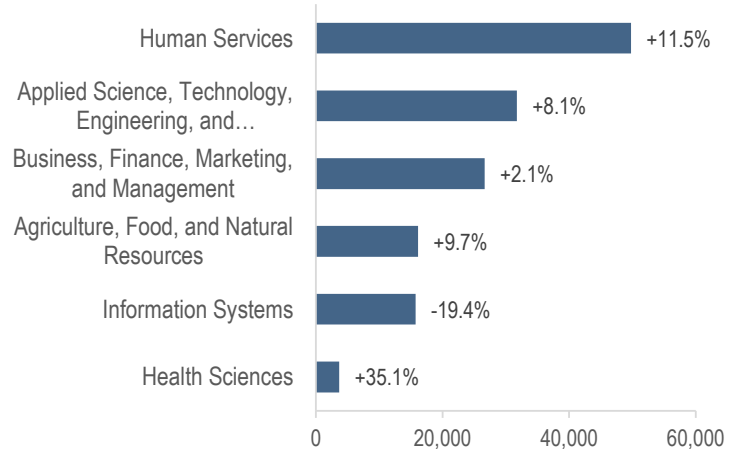
**96,916** Secondary CTE Enrollment **65.6%** of Total Student Enrollment
