


Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Funds — COVID-19


Iowa received \$71.6 million under the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) portion of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, \$64.4 million of which will go to Iowa school districts for the purpose of mitigating the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Allocations by School District



As part of the ESSER funds, all participating accredited nonpublic schools will be allocated an equitable share, allowing them to receive services related to COVID-19 disaster relief in that amount. Nonpublic schools do not receive actual dollars.
