

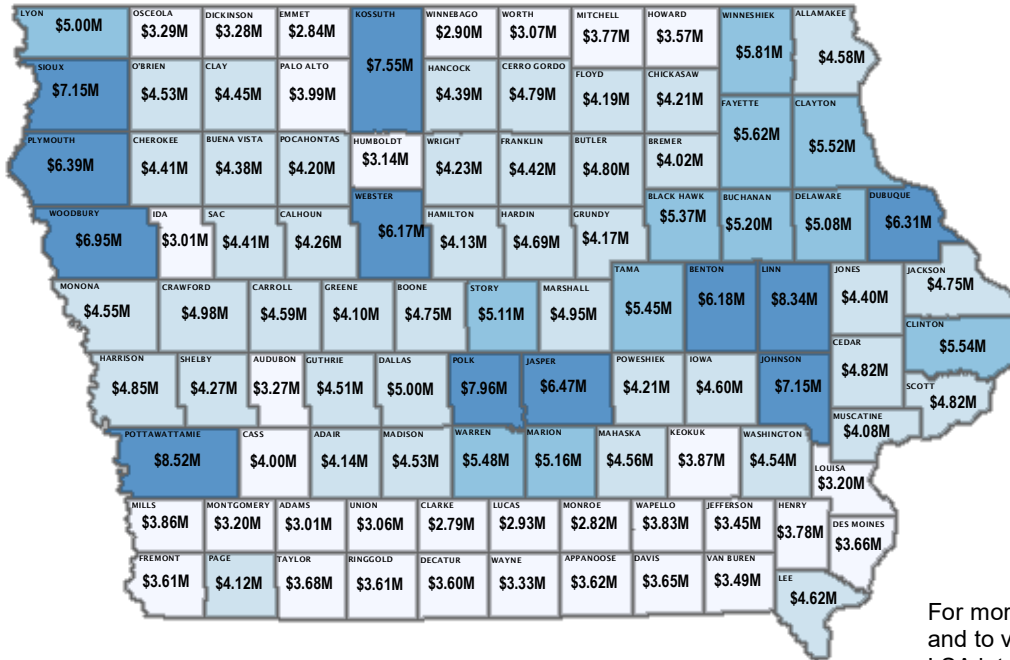
Road Use Tax Fund Distributions to Local Government — FY 2022

The Secondary Road Fund receives 24.5% of available funding in the Road Use Tax Fund (RUTF) after certain appropriations and statutory allocations are made. Counties also receive funding from the Farm-to-Market Road Fund, which receives 8.0% of RUTF receipts after appropriations and allocations. The Farm-to-Market Road funding is not reflected in this map.

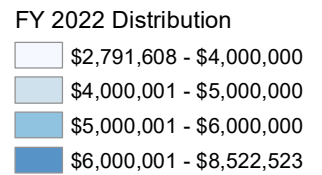
Counties receive distributions from the Secondary Road Fund based upon a formula that considers the area served in the county, rural population, vehicle miles traveled, road surfacing, and the linear feet of bridge deck of all structures.

The City Street Construction Fund receives 20.0% of RUTF receipts after certain appropriations and statutory allocations are made. Total City Street Construction Fund revenue is distributed proportionally based upon the last census. Counties also receive funding from the City Street Fund for transfer of jurisdiction payments, but these funds are not included in this visual.

Secondary Road Fund Distributions by County

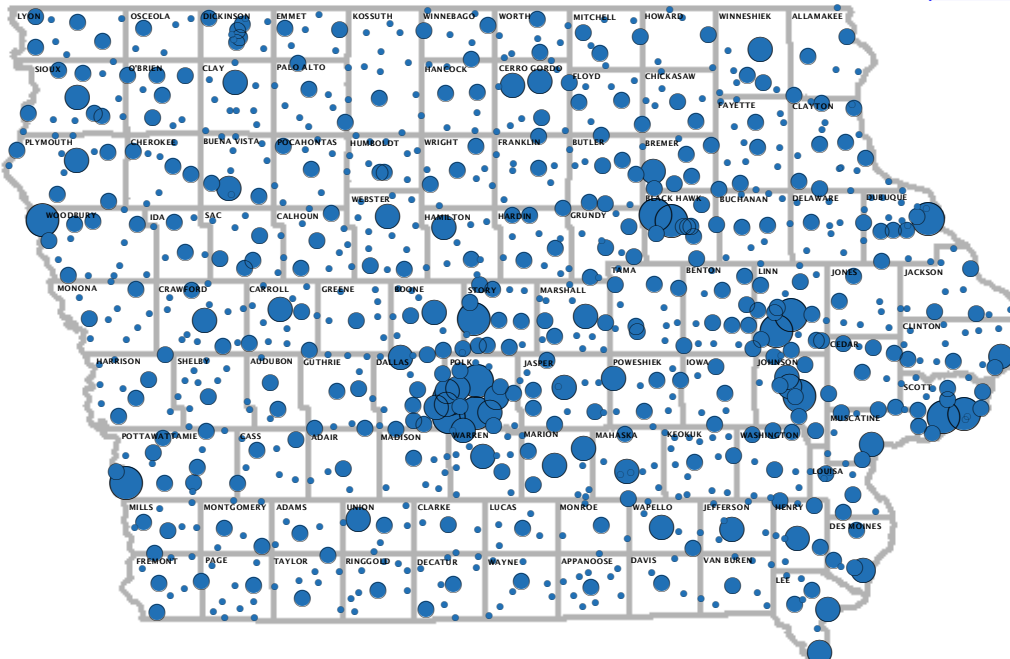
