



# Acres Enrolled in the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP)

CRP Acres Enrolled by Year




Total CRP acres statewide: 1,531,052

Note: Figures by county show the percent change in enrolled acres between FFY 2006 to FFY 2013. The Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) provides technical and financial assistance to eligible farmers and ranchers to address soil, water, and related natural resource concerns on their lands in an environmentally beneficial and cost-effective manner. The program is funded through the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC). The CRP is administered by the Farm Service Agency, with the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) providing technical land eligibility determinations, conservation planning and practice implementation.
