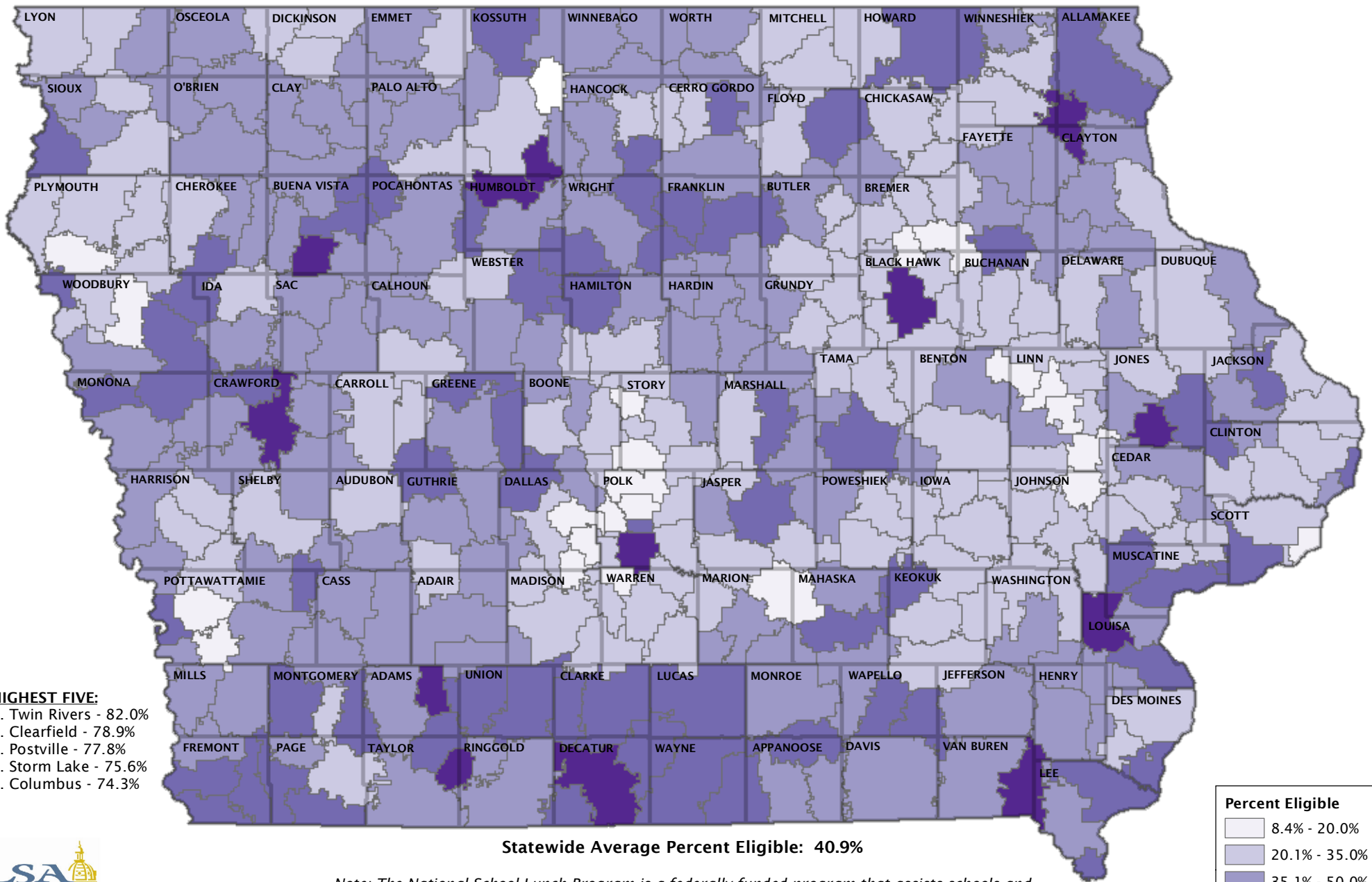


Percent of Enrollment Eligible for Free or Reduced Price Lunch

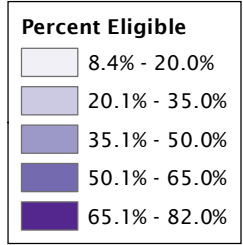
