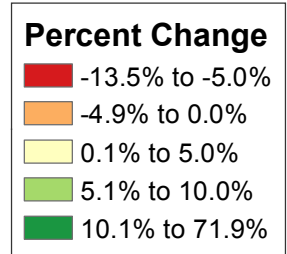
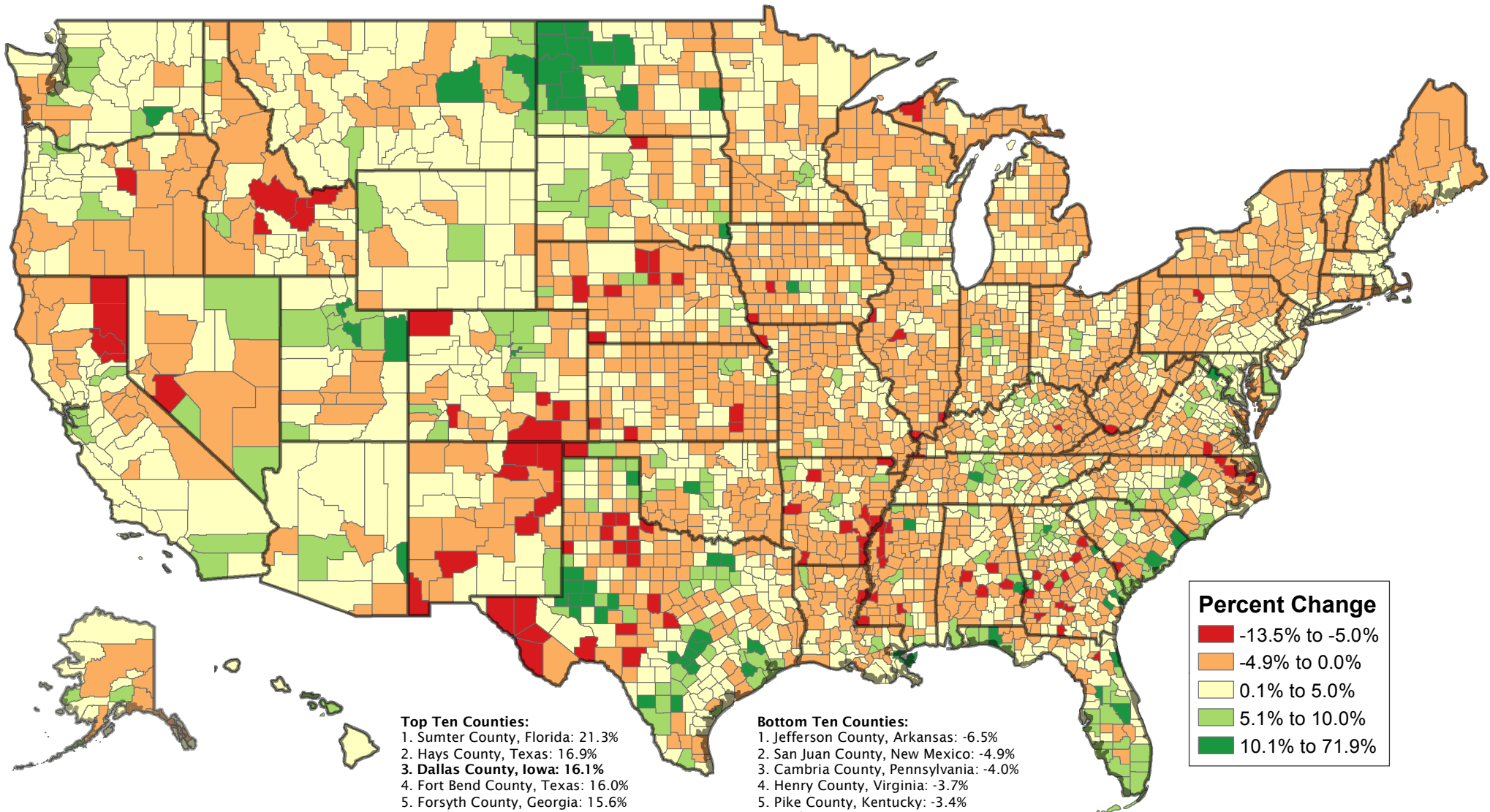


PERCENT CHANGE IN TOTAL POPULATION BY COUNTY 2010-2014
