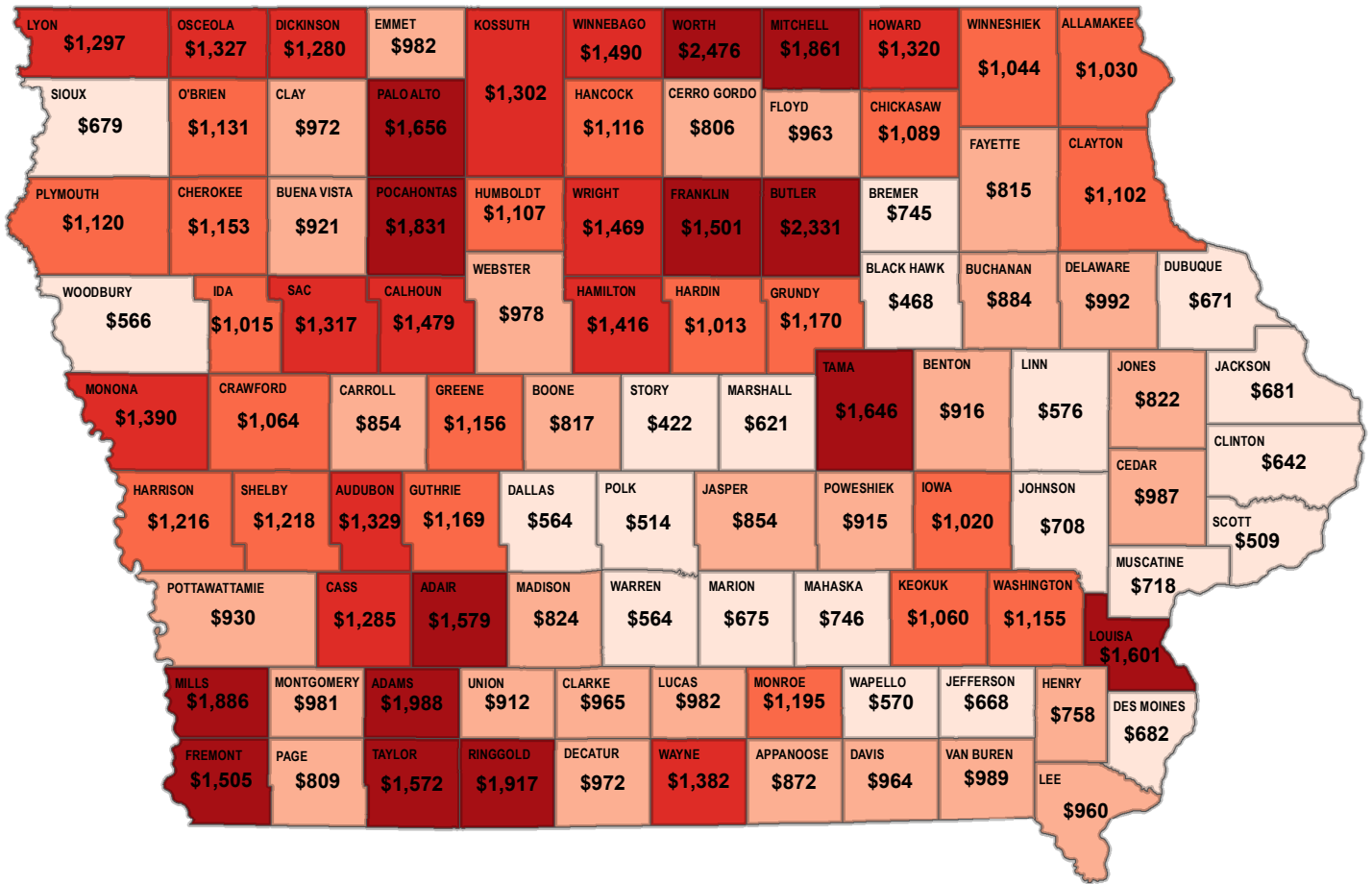
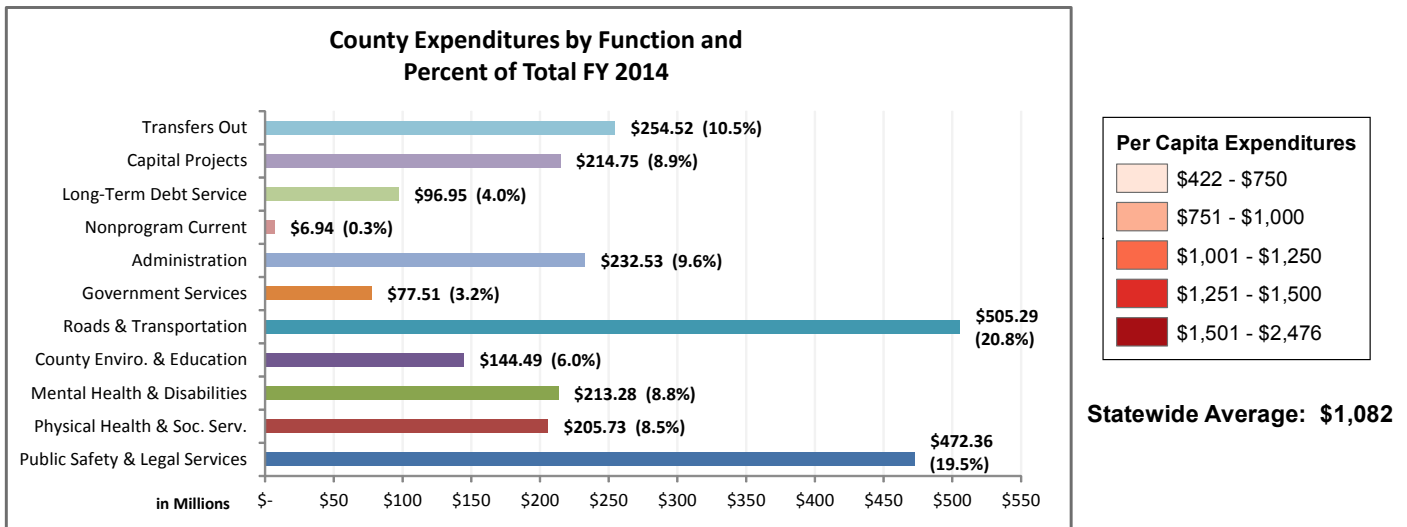


COUNTY GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURES PER CAPITA FROM ALL FUNDS FY 2014



NOTE: Per capita expenditures are calculated by dividing a county's total expenditures by the 2013 estimated population. There is a negative relationship between county size (either total expenditures or population) and per capita expenditures. That is, the larger counties spend less per person for county government service; this can be attributed to economies of scale.
