

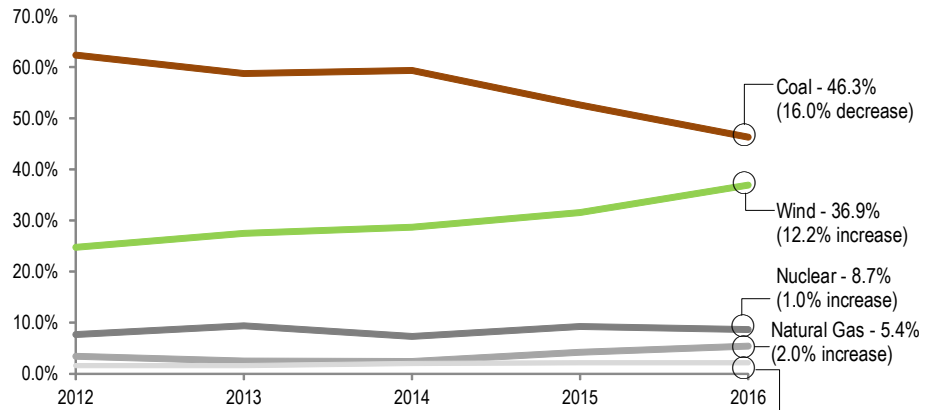
# Iowa Electricity Generation — 2016

## Quick Facts

- Five of Iowa's six largest power plants are coal-fired. Despite its decline, coal remains the primary fuel used for electricity generation.
- Iowa ranks highest in the amount of wind power used in net electricity generation.
- Since 2008, Iowa has generated more electricity each year than the state has consumed.

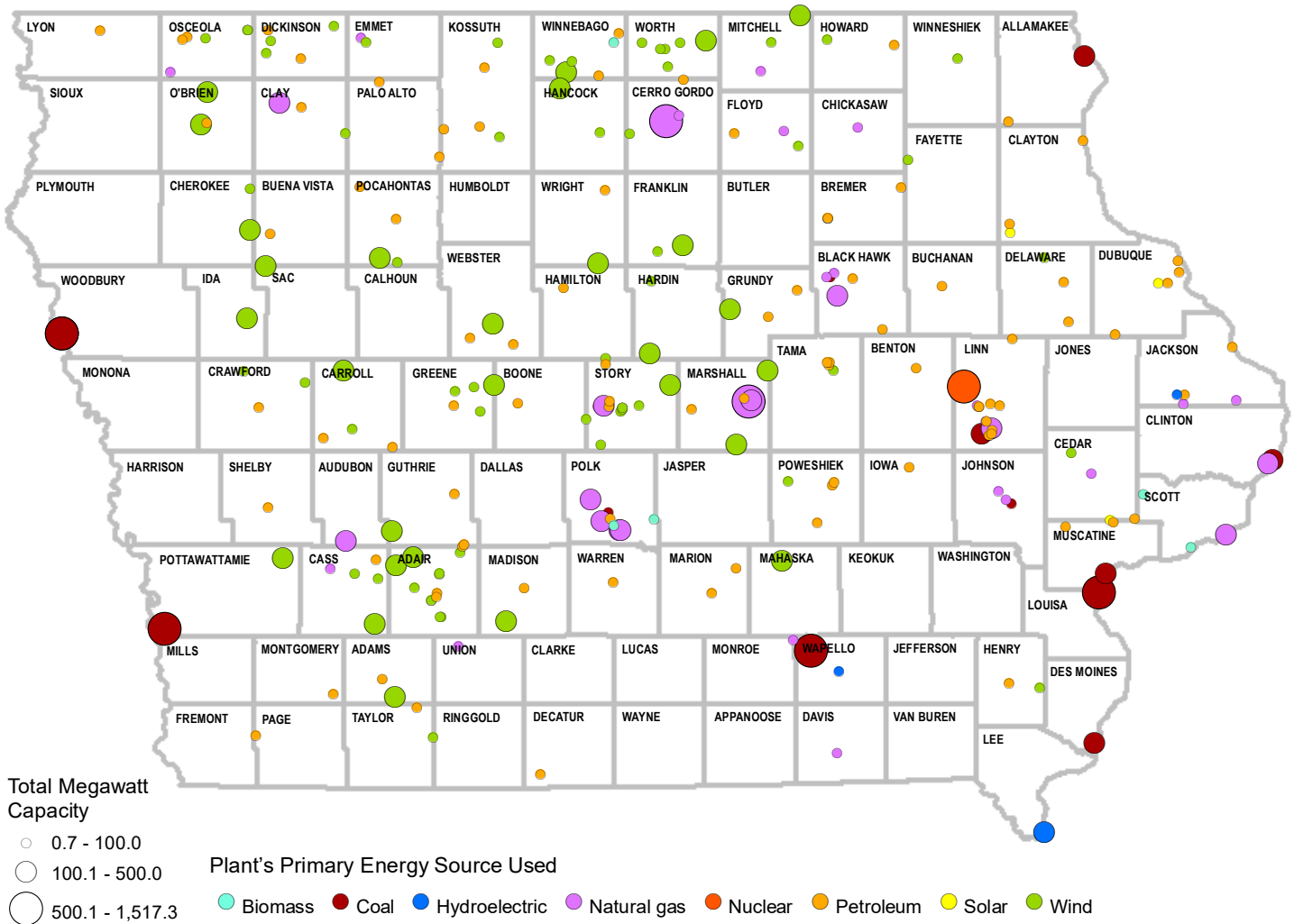
