This is a net increase of \$1.4 million and 7.0 FTE positions compared to estimated net FY 2019.</p> <p><b>FY 2020 Other Funds:</b> Appropriates a total of \$28.1 million from other funds for FY 2020. This is a net increase of \$1.3 million compared to estimated net FY 2019.</p>	<p><b><u>FUNDING SUMMARY</u></b>  <b>FY 2020 General Fund:</b> Appropriates a total of \$41.1 million from the General Fund and 561.8 FTE positions to the DCA, the IEDA, the IFA, the PERB, the IWD, the CSAC, and the BOR for FY 2020.
