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SIGNIFICANT CODE CHANGES

Provides that the \$400,000 appropriated to the Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management (HSEMD) during the 2021 Legislative Session in [HF 861](#) (FY 2022 Justice System Appropriations Act) for a study of the levee districts shall not revert to the General Fund until the close of FY 2023.

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EFFECTIVE DATE

This Bill is effective upon enactment.

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1 1 Section 1. 2021 Iowa Acts, chapter 166, section 21, is
 1 2 amended to read as follows:
 1 3 SEC. 21. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY
 1 4 MANAGEMENT APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from
 1 5 the general fund of the state to the department of homeland
 1 6 security and emergency management for the fiscal year beginning
 1 7 July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, the following amount,
 1 8 or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used to conduct a
 1 9 governance and funding of levee districts study:
 1 10 \$ 400,000
 1 11 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated in this
 1 12 section that remain unencumbered or unobligated at the close of
 1 13 the fiscal year shall not revert but shall remain available for
 1 14 expenditure for the purposes designated until the close of the
 1 15 succeeding fiscal year.

1 16 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
 1 17 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
